

### Easy to set up, Easy to use







- 1. Pairing
- a. Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone.
- b. Turn on the shutter by switching the On/Off button. The shutter will enter pairing mode and the indicator LED light will flash to show it's trying to pair.
- c. Clickon "AB Shutter 3" from the Bluetooth list & it should pair shortly after

2. For iPhones: Use with your phone's standard camera app.

For Android: Use with your phone's standard camera app. If this doesn't work, download and use Camera 360 Lite by PinGui Inc. from Google Play.
