



Charge battery




1. Power on: Press and hold the " O " for 3 seconds, then While the Bluetooth headset is charging, the Power Indicator the headphone will turn on with prompt "Power on" and Blue/ will show a Red LED light until fully charged. Once fully Red LED light will flash. charged, the light indicator will be Blue.

> 2. Power off: Press and hold the " " for 5s, then the headphone will turn off with prompt "Power off" and Red LED will light on for 2s then off.

3. Game mode: Please click the three times to enter the low-latency mode, which will be turned on with a "Di" voice. Click the power button three times, the game mode will be turned off with "DuDu" voice.

Connect for first time:

1.Press and hold power button for about 3 seconds, unit will power on, at the same time will enter pairing mode: you can hear voice tone " pairing." Then see the LED light blinks blue and red (between Aux in hole and Type-C



Music Play



- 1. Press (1): Music Play / Music Pause
- 2. Press the "+" button: Short press"+" button for Volume Up; Long press "+" button for Next Track
- 3. Press the "-" button; Short press the "-" button for Volume Down; Long press "-" button for Previous Track

Calling (Mobile Phone)



- 1. Short pressing power button to receive or end a call.
- 2. Long pressing power button for about 2s to reject a call.
