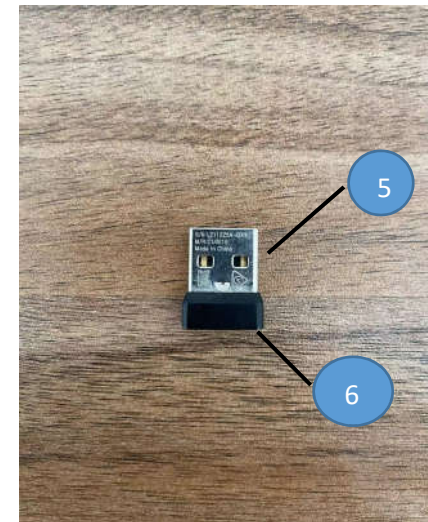
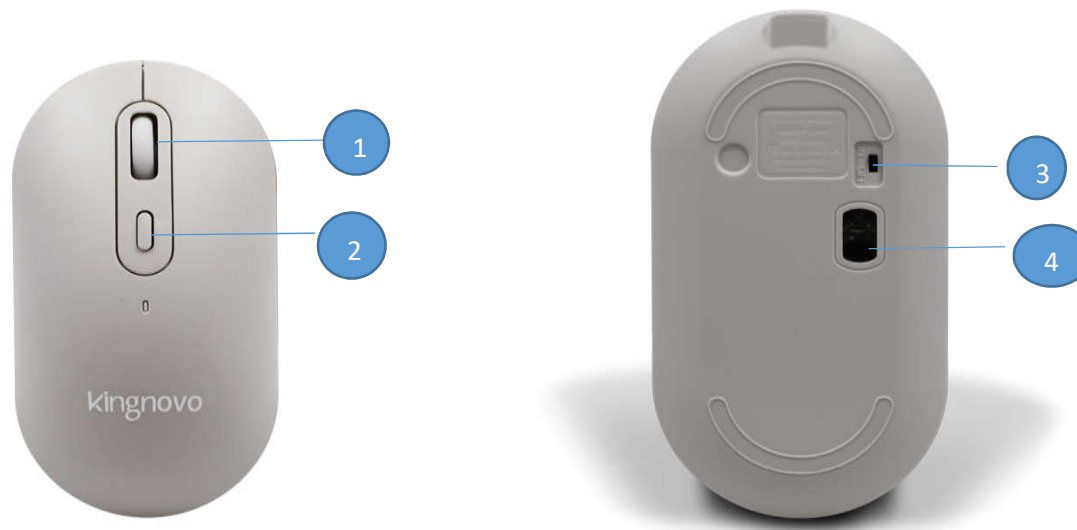

DESCRIPTION

1. Scroll wheel
2. DPI switch button (800/1200/1600)
3. On/Off slider switch
4. Optical sensor

5. USB connector

6. USB receiver

Problem	Solution
Mouse is not working	Check slider switch, it should be set up to "ON"
	Make sure that USB receiver is installed into USB port properly and distance to mouse is less than 10 m
	Check the polarity of the battery inside the mouse
	Check batteries, replace them with new ones if needed
