对讲连接条件: 需一台机器处于对讲接收模式, 一台机器处于对讲发射模式, 才能进行配对。

对讲模式灯光: 绿色指示灯快闪, 进入发射模式, 并有语音提示; 绿色指示灯慢闪, 进入接收模式, 并有语音提示; 此时两台对连, 连接成功后, 栅格内指示灯已1S间隔闪烁一次, 并伴有对讲连接成功提示音, 此时就可以进行对讲通话。

首次连接: 两台机器开机后, 短按对讲键, 进入对讲模式, 此时两台机器处于同一个模式对讲接收模式, 此时需长按其中一台对讲键, 使其进入对讲发射模式, 进行对讲配对。

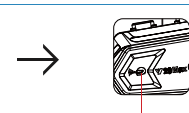
## Intercom pairing



Intercom key



Short press to enter the intercom mode, Short press again to exit the intercom mode;



Long-press toggle Intercom transmit and receive mode;

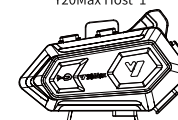
**Intercom connection conditions:** One machine needs to be in intercom receiving mode and one machine needs to be in intercom transmitting mode before pairing can be performed.

**Intercom mode light:** the green indicator blinks quickly and enters the emission mode with a voice prompt. When the green indicator blinks slowly, it enters the receiving mode, and a voice prompt is displayed. At this time, the two pairs are connected. After the connection is successful, the grid indicator blinks once at a 15 interval and the intercom connection is successful. At this time, the intercom conversation can be started.

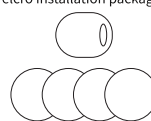
**First connection:** After the two machines are powered on, short press the intercom key to enter the intercom mode. At this time, the two machines are in the same mode of intercom receiving mode. At this time, long press one of the intercom keys to make it enter the intercom transmitting mode for intercom pairing.
