FCC response on 02/08/2017

If the device is unquestionably too small for the FCC ID to be readable (smaller than 4-6points), the FCC ID may be placed in the user manual. However, it must be determined that the device itself is too small – the label area allocated to the FCC ID may not be reduced because of overcrowded identification of other product and regulatory information.
