

Safety Notes:

The DVD video display of the in-dash unit will not operate while the vehicle is moving. This is a safety feature to prevent driver distraction. In-dash DVD video functions will only operate when vehicle is in Park and the parking brake is engaged. It is illegal in most states for the driver to view video while the vehicle is in motion.




TYPICAL FRONT-LOAD DIN MOUNTING METHOD

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Wiring Diagram – Inputs/Outputs




Control Locations



1. Reset - Press and hold to switch back to the original factory settings. This will erase all preset radio stations.

Select the Tuner icon from the Main Menu screen or press MODE until Tuner is selected.




Insert a CD in the disc slot, and the unit will read the disc. (Insert a USB/SD Card)



General Operations

Setup Menu

From the Main Menu screen, press Setup to enter the Setup Menu. The first 7 setup options will be displayed on the screen.



Bluetooth Operation

Bluetooth Microphone

Bluetooth features of the Multi Media function with the included external microphone, which is designed for mounting to the visor or A-pillar inside the vehicle.

Pairing and Connecting

Before you can use a Bluetooth device, it must be paired and connected. The Multi Media broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "Dual BT". The Bluetooth passcode "1234". Once pairing is complete, most Bluetooth will connect automatically if the device is in range when the Multi Media is powered-on.



Dialing a Number


Press to display keypad and dial a number.

Making and Ending a Call

Press to connect a call, and press to end a call.

Accessing Recent Call List

Press to access the recent call list and view/select numbers from recent Received, Dialed or Missed calls.



Transferring Audio

Press to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

Streaming Audio

Press to enter the music control menu.

Press to play or pause the music.

Press to skip to the previous track.

Press to advance to the next track.
