RF Exposure Information:

The SAR limit of USA (FCC) is 1.6W/kg averaged over one gram of tissue. Device Types (FCC ID: 2AC3S-TALKASET3) has also been tested against this SAR limit. The highest SAR value reported under this standard during product certification for use when properly worn on the body is 0.751 W/kg and for head is 0.541W/kg. Simultaneous RF exposure is 0.634W/Kg.
