

TS-200BC Halo Wireless Speaker & Lighting
USER MANUAL
(Read before proceeding)

Power Supply

1. Insert the USB cable to the micro socket of the unit. Connect to a 5V power switch for power supply.
(Both USB cable and power switch are included.)

Switch on/off & Connect/disconnect

1. To turn on/off the unit, switch the power button to “ON” or “OFF” position.
2. Long press the “Bluetooth” button to switch on Bluetooth function, the blue and red LED lights are flashing alternately.
3. The unit will automatically try to reconnect to the last Bluetooth device first. If not found, it will be seen by other Bluetooth devices.
4. On the Bluetooth device, switch on Bluetooth and search for “TS-200BC”. For the first-time connection, select “TS-200BC” to start connection. If necessary, enter the pass code 0000 or 1234. Once connected successfully, the blue light is always on.
5. To disconnect “TS-200BC” from current Bluetooth device, switch off Bluetooth from current Bluetooth device. Or press and hold “Bluetooth” button for 2 seconds to disconnect and search for another Bluetooth device.
6. After Bluetooth connected, long press “Bluetooth” button to switch off Bluetooth function.
7. If “TS-200BC” is not in used for a long time, it will turn off automatically.

Play music

1. After successful connection, start music play on the Bluetooth device. You can listen to music from “TS-200BC” wirelessly (< 33 ft.). The music streaming may be interrupted by obstacles between the device and the unit, such as walls, metallic casing that covers the device, or other devices nearby that operate in the same frequency.
2. Long press “+” or “-” to switch forwards or backwards to skip songs.
3. Short press “+” or “-” to control the volume.

LED lighting

1. When the unit is power on, touch the “Lighting Power” button on the top middle part to select different light modes as following order: White light mode - Selecting color normal mode - Selecting color dancing mode - Selecting color breathing mode – Gradually changing color mode – Switch off light.
2. On the White light mode and Selecting color normal mode, touch and hold the Circular Dotted Area on the top middle part to dimmer the light.
3. On select color mode, the lighting color can be selected by touch the top colorful circle.
