TS-507B

(Read before proceeding)

Charging and low battery power warning

1. Use the USB charge cable connecting to "TS-507B" from its micro charging port to your computer or charger. (The charging input is 5V 1A.)
2. The red light on top of the handle will turn off when power charging completes.
3. "TS-507B" should come with enough power to pair with your device. If you are having trouble on pairing or powering it, please make sure it is fully charged.

Music Playing:

1. Bluetooth Mode:
 - Press and hold the "Power / Play/Pause" button for three seconds to power it on.
 - Once power on, the unit turns default into Bluetooth mode, while there is no Micro SD card.
 - Your "TS-507B" will automatically connect to the last Bluetooth device firstly. If no found, it will enter pairing mode and wait for a new Bluetooth device to connect.
 - On the Bluetooth device, switch on Bluetooth setting and search for "TS-507B". For the first-time connection, select "TS-507B" to start connection. If necessary, enter the pass code 0000 or 1234. There is a warning tone once connected successfully.
 - To disconnect "TS-507B" from current Bluetooth device, choose to "Disconnect" or "Forget this device" from its connected Bluetooth device.
 - Under this mode, press one time the "Power / Play/Pause" button to play or pause music.
 - Under this mode, short press the "+" or "-" button to skip songs forwards or backwards. While press and hold these two buttons to adjust volume.
 - "TS-507B" can be connected with Bluetooth devices wirelessly (< 30 ft.) The music streaming may be interrupted by obstacles between the device and "TS-507B", such as walls, metallic casing that covers the device, or other devices nearby that operate in the same frequency.
2. AUX-in Mode
 - Use the audio cable to connect between your music device and your "TS-507B" through their 3.5mm audio port.
 - When insert the audio cable into your "TS-507B", it will switch to AUX-in Mode automatically.
 - Under this mode, press one time the "Power / Play/Pause" button to enter silent mode.
 - Skip songs and adjust volume from your music device.
3. TF card/USB drive:
 1. Once a TF Card is inserted, the unit will turn into TF Card mode and plays music automatically.
 2. Under this mode, press one time the "Play/Pause / Phone" button to play or pause music.
 3. Under this mode, short press the "+" or "-" button to skip songs forwards or backwards. While press and hold these two buttons to adjust volume.

Speakerphone

1. When there is an incoming call, music will pause automatically. Pick up or hang up phone call by short pressing the "Phone" button. Music play resumes when your call ends.
2. To reject an incoming call, please press and hold the "Phone" button.
3. Quickly press twice the "Phone" button to redial the last number.

4. The Speakerphone function is only available under Bluetooth mode.

FM Radio

1. Insert the USB charging cable to use it as antenna, press the “M” button to switch to Radio Mode.
2. Under this mode, press one time “Power / Play/Pause” button to search and lock all possible FM channels automatically. When the searching finishes, there is no channel changed.
3. Short press the “+” or “-” button to select a channel. While Press and hold the buttons to adjust volume.
