- *Please charge the bluetooth speakers on time, Since low battery power will affect the distance and could make disconnect.

1) Turn on the speaker

2) Bluetooth connection: Turn on the speaker and it will come to pairing mode automatically, blue lights flash. Turn on the bluetooth of your mobile and search for the speaker, When your phone find out the speaker, Choose and confirm to connect it. If need any password or Pin please enter 0000.

And this bluetooth speaker has memory connection function, It will connect with the last mobile automatically when next time using..

6. Compatibility:

Bluetooth 2.1+EDR or higher version of the device (the relevant agreements, please refer to general specifications), Such as IPAD, IPHONE, IPOD TORCH, MAC with Bluetooth , and most of Bluetooth smart phone or computer.

Unsuccessful pairing	1. Recheck if the speakers in the pairing mode. Or restart the speakers. 2. Too much bluetooth devices around causing the search difficult. Please close other Bluetooth devices. 3. Battery is low, Pls charge it in time.
Sound distorted/ Sound is low	1. Check the volume of the Bluetooth devices and adjust the volume to a proper Position. 2. The battery voltage is low, Please charge on time. 3. Battery is low, Pls charge it in time.
The music not smooth playing	1. Beyond the effective distance, or there is barrier between the speakers and devices. 2. Battery is low, Pls charge it in time.
