


Mini USB Charging Cable

Charging the Bluetooth Speaker

- Plug the Mini USB end of the included Mini USB cable into the USB port at the back of speaker.
- Plug the other end into a USB port on your computer or other devices made for USB charging.
- The LED indicator light on the back of the speaker lights up RED when charging.
- The LED indicator light turns off when finished charging.



Location of controls



- 1. Speaker
- 2. Tablet/Smartphone dock
- 3. Detachable strap


Back of Speaker



- 4. LED indicator light
- 5. AUX IN jack (LINE IN)
- 6. Mini USB port
- 7. DC5V charging port
- 8. Power ON/OFF switch
- 9. Battery door


Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device

- 1. Switch the ON/OFF switch to ON.
- The speaker will emit a series of beeps and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.
- Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.



On an iPhone

 Go to SETTINGS > GENERAL > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On a Blackberry

- Go to SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH
- Enable BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On an Android Phone

 Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU > Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)


On an Android Phone

 Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU > Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On other Cell Phones/Devices

 Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



- When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker, select "PBT3002" from the list of found devices.
- If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair the two units.
- After a successful pairing, the LED indicator light will slowly blink BLUE.



The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's interface and interaction with the **Bluetooth Speaker** may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

- The speaker will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps to start the pairing process pairing again.
- If the speaker cannot pair up with the last device within 10 minutes, it will enter sleep mode. Switch the speaker off and on again to wake it up.
- The speaker will automatically connect to the last device that it was paired to. To switch to another device, turn off the current paired device and restart the pairing process.
- If the speaker has already been connected to a Bluetooth device, the speaker will reconnect with the Bluetooth device automatically.
- Bluetooth will turn off when the 3.5mm Audio Cable is inserted. It will automatically pair with the last device when the Audio Cable is disconnected.

Using your Bluetooth Speaker

Powering ON/OFF

- To turn ON, slide the ON/OFF switch on the back of the speaker to the ON position.
- To turn OFF, slide the ON/OFF switch on the back of the speaker to the OFF position.

Playing Music

 Use the controls on your Bluetooth enabled device to control music playback and to raise or lower the volume.



Make sure the volume level of the connected audio player is turned up, otherwise the sound level of the speaker will be weak.



Most media enabled smart phones will display "Connected to phone audio and media" when connecting to the Bluetooth Speaker. This means you can make phone calls and enjoy your music.

Using as a wired speaker

- 1. Turn on the unit.
- 2. Connect the one end of the included 3.5mm Audio Cable to the LINE IN jack on the back of the speaker, and the other end of the cable to the output jack on your computer or any personal music player such as a mobile phone or tablet.
- Open a media player on your computer, mobile phone, or tablet, and click on PLAY to start playing your music.
- Use the controls on your connected device to control music playback.

Battery use

This speaker comes with a rechargeable battery but it can also use 4 AA Alkaline batteries (not included) as well. There is no need to remove the rechargeable battery if you are using AA Alkaline batteries.

To install and use AA batteries follow the instructions below:

- Open the battery compartment on the back of the speaker.
- Install AA batteries be sure to match the polarities.
- Close the battery compartment.

Note: If both battery types are inserted, when the alkaline batteries' voltage is lower than the rechargeable battery, the speaker will be powered by the rechargeable battery; but if the AA Alkaline batteries' voltage is higher than the rechargeable battery, the speaker will be powered by the AA Alkaline batteries.

You can charge the rechargeable battery while the alkaline batteries are inserted.

Troubleshooting tips



I can pair the Bluetooth Speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music?

- Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
- 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
- You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.



- Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
- The speaker will emit a series of beeps and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.
- 3. The speaker is now in pairing mode



My Bluetooth Device is not able to pair with the Bluetooth Speaker.

- Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
- Keep your Bluetooth Speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- The speaker will emit a series of beeps and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.
- Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
- 5. Try repeating the pairing process, see "Pairing the Speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device".
