on the Aurora Wireless Charger



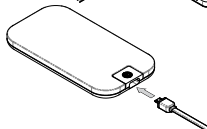
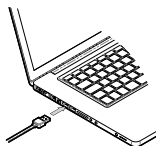
2. Green light will turn blue to show

NOTES

1. Do not disassemble or throw into fire or water.
