



Batteries Installation For Smart Light



① Push



② Pull Out

To install batteries into the Smart Light, open the battery box cover to access battery compartment. Insert 3 x "AAA" 1.5V batteries (Not Included) into the battery box. Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram. Put back in place the battery box cover.

Notice:

When placing the batteries, you must insert according to the correct polarity, the Smart Light won't function if batteries are reversed.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

a. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.

b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.

c. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.

d. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.

e. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.

2. Should this product cause, or be affected by local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching ON & OFF again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
