

# SAFETY/CARE NOTES:

When used for the first time, please ensure that the volume is on a low setting as excessive volume may cause damage to the unit and potentially impair your hearing. Please keep your speaker away from liquids, excessive moisture, rainwater, sand, dust, dirt and heat sources. To clean your speaker, please use a dry dust cloth.

# BLUETOOTH CONNECTION:

- Press and hold the power ON button for 3 seconds and the blue LED will flash continually. You will hear a voice prompt telling you that the speaker is ready to be connected to your Bluetooth® device.
- Activate your Bluetooth® device and search for 'ASHLEY MARY SPEAKER'. When connected you will hear a voice prompt telling you that you have connected to the speaker, the blue LED will stay on.

### HANDS FREE VOICE CALLING:

The speaker is equipped with a microphone that enables hands free voice calling. Your device must be connected to the speaker via Bluetooth® to enable hands free calling. Press the button once on

the speaker to answer the call, press again to cancel the call.

When you answer the call on your device the sound will automatically be transmitted from the speaker. Please note, some devices will require you to change manually. Please note that when using Skype® from your Bluetooth® device you will need to answer and cancel the call manually from your Bluetooth® device.

### MUSIC:

When your Bluetooth® device is connected to the speaker, you can begin to play music.

## **BLUETOOTH® ANTI-THEFT ALARM FEATURE:**

Once your phone or other Bluetooth® device is connected, the Anti-Theft feature will activate.

If your speaker and Bluetooth® device is over 32 feet away from each other, the alarm will sound. The Bluetooth® device will reconnect when back in range.

# **BLUETOOTH® CAMERA SHUTTER FUNCTION:**

When you are connected you can take photos by pressing the play button on the Bluetooth® speaker when connected to your camera APP.

This item is compatible with Apple devices running iOs 5 or later and with Android devices running 4.3 or later. If using an Android device, you may need to configure the camera settings for the volume key to act as the camera key. If you are using an older version, you will need a third-party camera APP to allow for camera key configuration. Please note, some non-Android or iPhone devices will not operate this feature.

#### CHARGING:

When the battery is running low a voice prompt will sound to alert you of this.

To charge the speaker, connect to a PC or USB DC5V power source via the USB cable supplied. When charging, the red light on the front of your speaker will be illuminated and will turn off when the battery is fully charged.

The speaker takes 2 hours to fully charge if not in use while charging. You may use this speaker while charging; however, this will increase the time required to fully charge the battery. Once fully charged the speaker will last up to 2.5 hours.

# TROUBLESHOOTING:

- 1. Speaker will not turn on: Check your speaker is charged by following the charging instructions.
- 2. Unable to connect to speaker via Bluetooth®: Ensure your speaker is switched ON. Ensure your Bluetooth® device is within range of your speaker (32 feet without obstruction). Check that your device is paired with the ASHLEY MARY SPEAKER.
- 3. No output on speaker: Ensure that the volume is turned up on your device.
