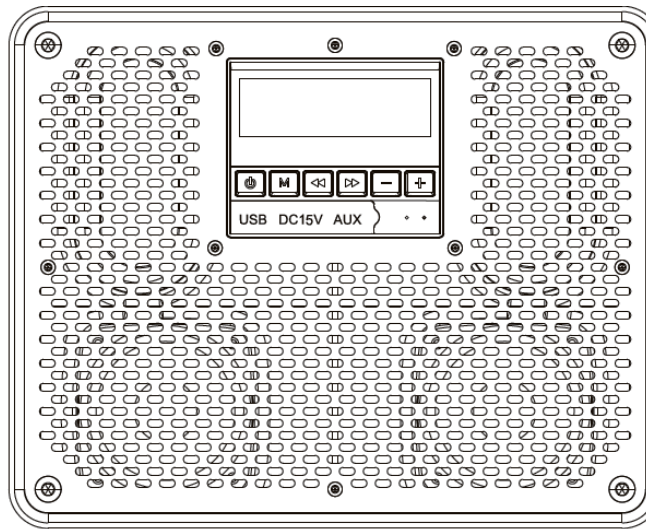

ATTENTION: Do NOT charge while the unit is wet. Towel dry the unit AND make sure all connections are dry BEFORE plugging in the charging connector.

CARE, MAINTENANCE & PRECAUTIONS

1. The unit is waterproof when the silicone tab is properly closed.
2. Close the silicone tab properly before exposure to water. Without the silicone tab properly closed, water may enter into the unit and void your warranty.
3. Dry unit completely before opening the cap. Do NOT open the cap if wet or in a wet environment.
4. Do NOT apply excessive force to the LCD or control buttons when wet or in a wet environment.
5. Do NOT use or store the unit in places with high temperature.
6. AVOID prolonged exposure to ultraviolet radiation (UV sunlight) and strong magnetic fields.
7. Periodically check the silicone seal for premature wear.
8. Periodically clean the tab with a soft moist cloth and ensure no objects such as dirt, hair or sand are on the silicone seal tab. Do NOT use any oily solvent or chemicals for cleaning.
9. Rinse off the unit with tap water after use in salt water or swimming pool.
10. Noise and audio distortion may occur when the batteries are nearing end of charge.
11. Do NOT remove the built-in battery. Do NOT remove the grill covers.

This unit has been tested and approved for IPX 5, with the silicone tab in place.

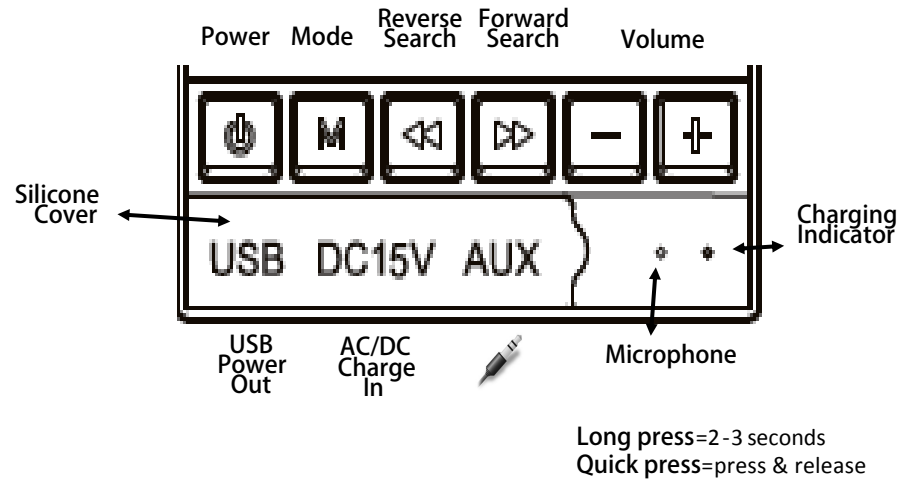

Controls

Power On: Long press the power button, the unit will announce "power on."

Power Off: Long press the power button, the unit will announce "power off."

Reverse : Quick press for incremental change / long press for search.

Forward : Quick press for incremental change / long press for search.

Volume -- : Quick press for incremental change / hold down for rapid change.

Volume + : Quick press for incremental change / hold down for rapid change.

Note* 3 beep tone will indicate maximum volume when bluetooth mode.

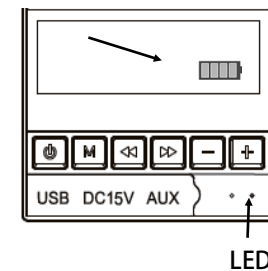

Before you Begin:



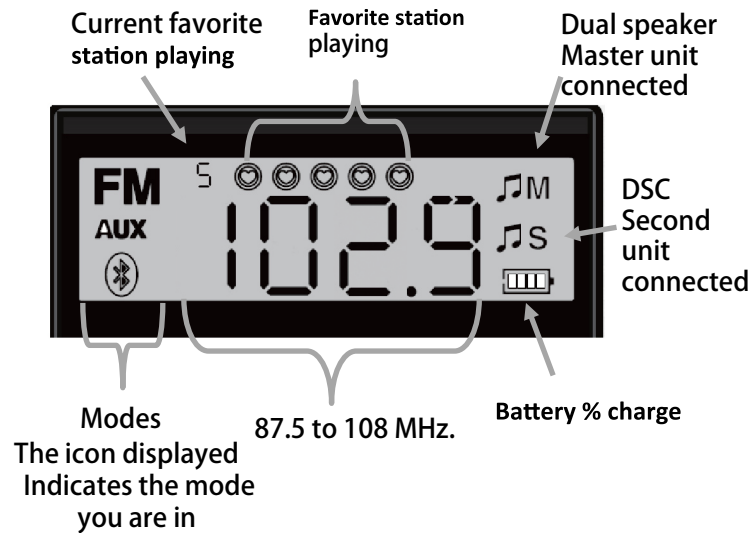
Before using your *ArcticBlu* audio for the first time, charge the unit until the front LED battery charging indicator changes from red to green—indicating a full charge, when powered on, the LCD display will show a battery icon indicating the level of charge; 25%->100%.

Charge time is typically 2 to 3 hours. Play time is 8 to 10 hours at 60%-70% volume.

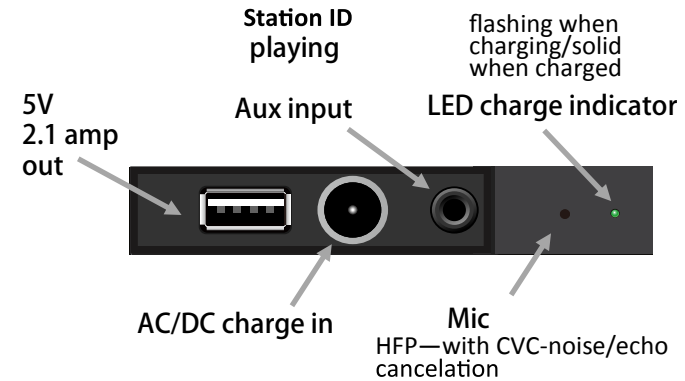

LED Display

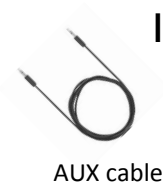

MODES

ArcticBlu™

1. Bluetooth®—the unit is defaulted to power on in BT mode.
2. FM Radio—enjoy your local radio stations, save up to 5 of your favorite stations.
3. Auxiliary — direct connect with the supplied 3.5mm Aux cable.

How to pair your device



Step 1: Find & enable Bluetooth® on your device.

Step 2: In BT mode, hold down the “M” Button; “BT ” icon will flash with an indication tone “pairing”.

Step 3: Find & select "ArcticBlu " - when the device connects, the “BT ” icon will stop flashing; following - “your device is connected”.

Reconnecting : Each time you power on the unit, it will automatically search for the last BT device connection and connect. If you want a different device connected, you must hold the “M” button for "pairing".

Play & Pause : Quick press the power button for pause- and resume play.

Next Song : Quick press the » button for next song from your device.

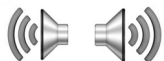
Last Song : Quick press the « button for next song from your device.

Note* Unlike most devices, Arctic Blu will not appear automatically on your music source device. You must hold down the “M” button until “pairing” is announced. To connect another device, you must disconnect your devices BT, then hold down the “M” button to make the unit re-discoverable. There are no codes required to connect.

DSC

Dual Speaker Connection - connect two *ArcticBlu* coolers up to 60 feet apart!

Note* (True Wireless), *DSC* only works in BT mode. The two units must have a clear line of sight. Obstacles, such as cars, walls, humans, large animals and aliens may cause interruption of play between the two coolers.

Make the first unit the "Master" and the second unit the "Secondary"



M

Quick press the "M" and then the "Volume Up."

This icon will flash while connecting - stop flashing when connected.



S

On the second unit -quick press the "M" and then the "Volume Down."

This icon will flash while connecting - stop flashing when connected.

In 10 seconds both units will announce *"Connection Successful."*

Manually Disconnect: To exit DSC mode, press VOL+ and VOL- at the same time.

Tips on placing the speaker



When using your speaker indoors, the tonal quality can vary depending on where the speaker is placed in a room. When using your speaker outdoors, you should expect the tonal quality to change as you move farther away from the speaker. Visit www.ArcticBluaudio.com for best performance speaker placement.

Tuning: Quick press » or « for next increment channel.

Auto Search: Long press the » or « ; the display will “flash” the current station will auto change to the next available station.

Save 5 Fav's: To save the current station you are listening to-as a favorite station- quick press both « and » buttons simultaneously.

Confirm station: Confirm setting: short press « and » together.

Listen to Fav's: To toggle through the saved favorite stations-quick press the mode “M” and either the » or « buttons.

Change a favorite: When listening to saved station and want to change it,press » or « button to adjust favorite station then quick press «and» buttons together,the previous saved station would be insteaded by current favorite station.



AUX

AUX-IN: Connect to play an audio device using a 3.5mm audio cable.

Phone: **Note*** Your mobile device connected can perform all the functions listed below. Should you not have access to your mobile phone, the unit can manage the calls.

Answer Calls: Music will automatically fade and a ringtone will announce.
Quick Press the "Power" button to answer.

Terminate Call: Quick Press the "Power" button." -

Refuse Calls: Long press the "Power" button.

Cancel a dial: Quick Press the "Power" button.

Transfer call: During a current call, long press "Power" button, the call will transfer to mobile device.

Mute the call: Long press of the "Forward" button. Re-press the "Forward" button to resume Mic

Redial last call: Pause the music then long press Volume "+" buttons.

Note* You can also control the call features from your mobile device.

Note* The unit will automatically power down if not in use for 15 minutes.
