In accordance with Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, **Aiut sp. z o.o.** hereby requests long-term confidential treatment of internal photos accompanying this application. This is justified by the fact that circuit boards of the device are fully encapsulated with epoxy resin. The encapsulant is non transparent and therefore makes the observation of the circuit boards impossible. The device is designed as irreparable, neither service staff nor users can remove encapsulant without destroying the device. In the event of technical failure, the device must be replaced with a new one.

As mentioned the internal photos term regards in this document to the photos exposing internal assembly of a device - all those elements that are not visible, not accessible, together making a unique solution of a design hidden under the epoxy.

By this understanding the SIM card - a standard, not encapsulated, visible and accessible part – should be considered as an external element. Photos showing that element are not considered internal and should be included to an external photos set.
