

## **RF Exposure Evaluation**

1. The corresponding SAR Exclusion Threshold condition, listed below:

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances ≤ 50 mm are determined by:

FCC ID: 2ANQTJ-95U

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance,mm)]  $\cdot$  [ $\sqrt{f(GHz)}$ ] The test Result is less than 3.0 for 1-g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR.

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)] .[Vf(GHz)]≤3.0 for 1-g SAR and≤7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR,16 where

- > f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz
- > Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation
- > The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison

## 2. CL ASSIFICATION

The test exclusions are applicable only when the minimum test separation distance is  $\leq$  50 mm and for transmission frequencies between 100 MHz and 6GHz. When the minimum test separation distance is  $\leq$  5 mm, a distance of 5 mm is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

## 3. SAR TEST EXCLUSION THRESHOLDS

Per KDB 447498 D01, when the minimum test separation distance is < 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm is applied to determine RF Exposure test exclusion. The test exclusion threshold is 0.1862 which is<= 3, RF Exposure testing is not required.

Note: Exclusion Thresholds Results=[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)]  $\cdot [\sqrt{f(GHz)}]$ 

f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz Distance=5mm

Conclusion: No SAR is required.
