


| Components



- *Ahead main device*
- *Micro 5 pin USB cable*
- *Product box*
- *3 pieces of mount*

Flat mount

For the use of attaching the device onto table, wall, anywhere with flat surfaces.

Curved mount

For the use of attaching helmets or rounded surface. Mostly works with motorcycle, ski and safety helmets.

Velcro Strap mount

For the use of attaching skeleton helmets, (bicycle helmets)

+ Redundant tapes that place under the mount are included.

How to Attach Ahead to the Helmet

I To attach Ahead onto the helmet, please do the followings



Step 1 | Pick the right mount for the helmet, Remove the backing paper from the mount.

Step 2 | Place the mount downward facing down and be sure that rounded corner of the mount facing towards your mouth.



Step 3

Insert the device into the hook of the mount and slide down until it clicks. When the device clicks right, "this is your best friend, Ahead" voice comes out and the power gets turned on.



When attaching mount onto the helmet, make sure there is no dust or contaminants on the tape. Mount will not work well with the stuff on it and loosened mount can cause the entire device fall and break.

※ The red rubber band is intended to be wrapped around the mid-level of the bottom box, then the top box should be placed until where the red rubber band places. After all, the packaging box becomes a speaker.

How to Connect Ahead

I Pairing ready

To pair with a new device (phone etc), get to the Ahead's paring ready mode.

- ① Press volume up (+) & down (-) button down and hold them for at least 3 seconds. The red and blue LEDs will be alternately blinking, then you are ready to pair.
- ② Find your Bluetooth device on your phone. You will see "Ahead_1122" in the list. When pairing is complete, you can hear the voice prompt "Ahead is connected."

- Plug the AC adapter or charger into an outlet that is near the equipment and will be easily accessible.
- Never charge the battery where the temperature may fall below 0°C (32°F) or rise above 40°C (104°F)
- Avoid charging the battery while it is unattended.
