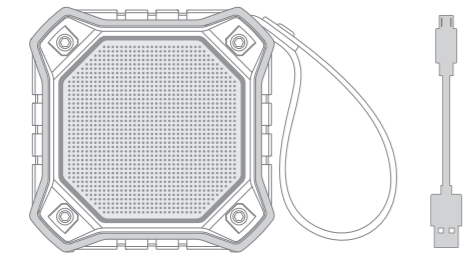

Product Introduction:

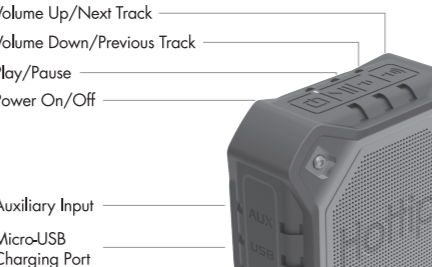

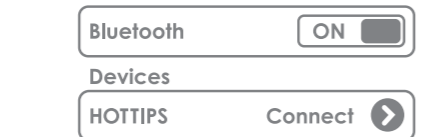

Function Instructions:

- **Power:** To turn the speaker On and Off, Long press the button until you hear "power on" or "power off."
- **Connecting Bluetooth®:** Once speaker is turned on, it will automatically send its pairing signal to your device. In your device's Bluetooth® settings, find "Hottips" and click connect. Once your device and your Hottips! Waterproof Wireless Speaker is connected you will hear a nice soothing voice saying "paired."
- **Play/Pause:** Press to Play and again to Pause.
- **Volume Up:** Press to turn volume up.
- **Volume Down:** Press to turn volume down.
- **Next Song:** Press for 1 second to go to a next song/track.
- **Previous Song:** Press for 1 second to go to a previous song/track.
- **Calling Functions:** Press when there is an incoming call and press again to end call. Hold for about 2 seconds to reject incoming call.
- **Low Battery Warning:** Hear a "battery low" voice beep and the RED LED will flash.
- **Language Settings:** To change speaker from default English language hold down the and buttons until you find your language of choice. If you rather no voice at all, click through language options until you hear a beeping sound.

Dual Speaker Stereo Pairing:

If you want to **Double Your Sound**, buy a second Hottips!® IPX7 Waterproof Wireless Speaker and pair them together for a louder stereo experience! With **Advanced TWS Technology**, the 2 connected speakers are capable of being up to 33ft. apart in case you want your music at **both** sides of the pool!

1. Turn on both Hottips!® IPX7 Waterproof Wireless Speakers. Press the and the simultaneously for 5 seconds until the voice indicator says "Paired."
2. Activate Bluetooth® on your device and connect to "Hottips." Press and again for 5 seconds to unpair speakers.

Waterproof Safety:

Guaranteed safe in the shower, the rain, by the pool or on a boat. If water does get into speaker make sure to dry out before use. Do Not submerge in water for over **30 minutes** or over **3 feet** deep. However possible it is, the speaker is not intended to play music or make calls while submerged under the water's surface. **WARNING:** Close USB flap tightly before exposing speaker to water to prevent permanently damaging Hottips!® IPX7 Waterproof Wireless Speaker.



Charging Your Device:

1. Connect the included micro-USB charger to the charging port on the left side of the speaker and connect the other end to a USB power supply. During charging, the LED indicator light will turn RED. Once the RED LED indicator light turns BLUE the speaker is now fully charged and ready to be unplugged from the Micro-USB to USB charger!

LED Indicators:

- **Power On:** The left LED indicator shows solid Blue.
- **Bluetooth Pairing:** Blue light flashes quickly when connecting and flashes slowly once connected.
- **Line-In:** Blue light flashes slowly when connected.
- **Charging:** Red light flashes when battery is running low and solid Red while charging. Light will turn solid Blue when charging is complete.

FAQ:

- **Aux Line-In:** Line-in connection is priority over Bluetooth®. Once cable is unplugged, speaker will automatically connect back to device's Bluetooth®.
- **Energy Save:** Speaker will automatically turn off after 2 minutes if not connected or playing. If connected to Bluetooth® but not playing, speaker will automatically shut off after 15 minutes.

Troubleshooting:

- **Poor Sound Quality:** Make sure the speaker and device are paired within the transmission distance of 33ft. and with no barrier between them.
- **Bluetooth Cannot Be Paired:** Ensure that both speaker and device are in pairing mode. If the Blue LED indicator is not flashing quickly, please restart the speaker until it is. Check the Bluetooth® settings on your device to ensure Bluetooth® is enabled and that your device is not in airplane mode.
- **Cannot Charge Speaker:** First check your charging cable and power source connection. If that doesn't work, try using a different micro-USB to USB charging cable to see if that is the problem.

Attention:

2. Do not modify, repair or dismantle Hottips!® IPX7 Waterproof Wireless Speaker. Doing so may result in fires, electric shocks, complete breakdown of speaker, etc. All if which are not covered under warranty.
3. Do not use any dilutents or volatile liquid to clean Hottips!® IPX7 Waterproof Wireless Speaker.
