Ensure the headphone is fully charged. 2. Make sure you are using a Bluetooth compatible device.</div> <div>Charging the Headphone</div> <div>1. Please charge the headphone by using power adapter(Output Voltage: DC 5V) or Use the charging line to connect the computer's usb port to charge,you can also charge with the wireless charging box. 2. The headphones LED indicator will in red when the battery is charging; and will go out when it's full of electricity. 3. The charging box LED indicator will in blue when the battery is charging; The four lamps represent 25%, 50%, 75%,100% electricity, when the charging box full of electricity ,The 4 lights are bright blue at the same time.</div> <div></div> <div>Charging line wireless charging box</div> <div>03</div>	<div>Bluetooth Mode</div> <div>1. Pairing the headphone a. Make sure the Bluetooth device is turned on. b. Hold the power button and the LED indicator will be flashing in red and blue. The headphone is now ready for pairing. c. Search for "S128" on your Bluetooth device, then connect it. [Note] If the Bluetooth version on your mobile is below V2.1, you will need to enter the password "0000" in order to connect to the headphones. d. The headphone is now ready to use; you can use it to play music or make a phone call. e. When your Bluetooth device restarts, the headphones will automatically pair with it. 2. Multi-pairing 2 in 1 a. Pair the headphone with your mobile phone A first. b. Then turn off the Bluetooth function on mobile A. c. Turn on the Bluetooth function on your mobile B to pair the same headphone set. d. Turn back on Bluetooth function on mobile A; now the headphones will automatically pair with mobile A. e. The headphones are now paired with both phones. 3. Wearing method a. Please note the headphones are labeled with L/R. Multi-function key ① Voice answer When you get a call, you will hear a voice guide "Yes" or "No" after saying caller ID. A second later, say "Yes" to answer or say "No" to reject call.</div> <div>05</div>	<div></div> <div>② Play/pause When you playing music,pressing this key to pause,pressing it again to resume. ③ Call switching When you calling,pressing the multifunction key for about 2 seconds,the voice will automatically switch to telephone receiver,vice versa ④ Re-calling function Pressing the multifunction key twice to make a phone call to the last person you have called. 5. "+" (V+) ① When you playing music,press "+" to play the previous track.when you calling or playing music,press and hold the "+" to increase the volume until you hear "du",the volume is now maximized.Or you can just keep clicking until you are satisfied with the volume.</div> <div>06</div>	<div>② A key to start the iPhone Siri function Press the "+" key twice to start the iPhone Siri function. </div> <div>[Tips] Properly adjust the volume as maximized volume can affect and damage your hearing. 6. "-" (V -) When playing music, press "-" to play the next track.When calling or playing music, Long press the "-" to reduce the volume until you hear "du". Now the volume is minimum or muted. </div> <div>[Note]Your cellphone must support A2DP.</div> <div>07</div>	<div>7. Online standby After pairing the first time, the headphones will automatically pair with the last device you used when you turn Bluetooth on. If connection fails, the Bluetooth will automatically shut down after 5 seconds. 8. Battery low alert The red light flashes once every 5 seconds and beeps every 30 seconds. These are the signals that the headphones needs to be charged. [Note] The headphone will automatically shut down while charging. 9. Chinese/English voice prompt switch The original setting for these headphones is the English voice prompt. If you would like to choose the Chinese voice prompt, set up the headphones first.After 2 seconds, press the power key twice, the voice prompt will switch to Chinese. Press the power key twice again, the voice prompt will switch back to. 10. Ensure the headphones is fully charged. 2. Make sure the Bluetooth function is turned on in order for your phone to setup. 3. Ensure the headphones has not been paired with another Bluetooth device. The headphone must be on standby when it's the first time pairing. 4. Once the headphone some mode failed to work ,please charge it . 5. Ensure the headphone and your cellphone is among 10 meters in distance.</div> <div>09</div>	<div>Warning A. Please shut down the headphones before putting it into your pocket or bag to avoid accidentally pressing the multifunction key. B. Do not expose the headphones into liquid or moist areas. C. Do not use abrasive solvents to clean the headphones. D. Do not put the headphones into an environment that has very high or very low temperatures. The suitable temperatures range from -10 degrees to 60 degrees. If it goes beyond these temperatures, it will affect the life of the headphones. E. Do not expose the headphones into open fire to avoid the danger of explosions. F. Do not let sharp objects touch the headphones; it will lead to scratches and damages. G. Do not insert any objects into the headphones; it will damage the internal components and functions. H. Do not disassemble the headphones. I. If you will not use the headphones for a long period of time, please keep them in a dry environment. If they will not be used for over a month please fully charge them first.
