

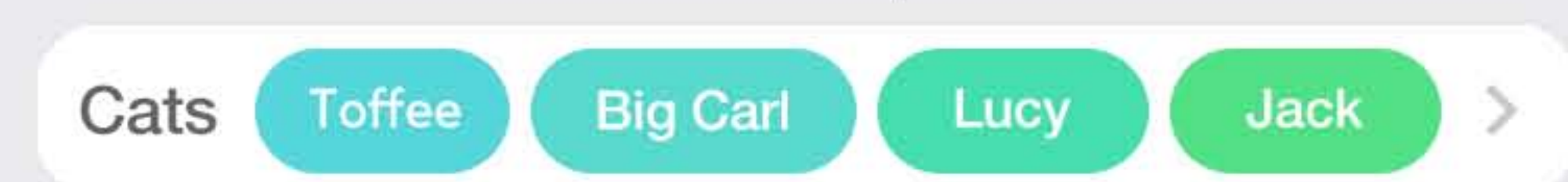

## user manual smart feeder

### 3 add your cats

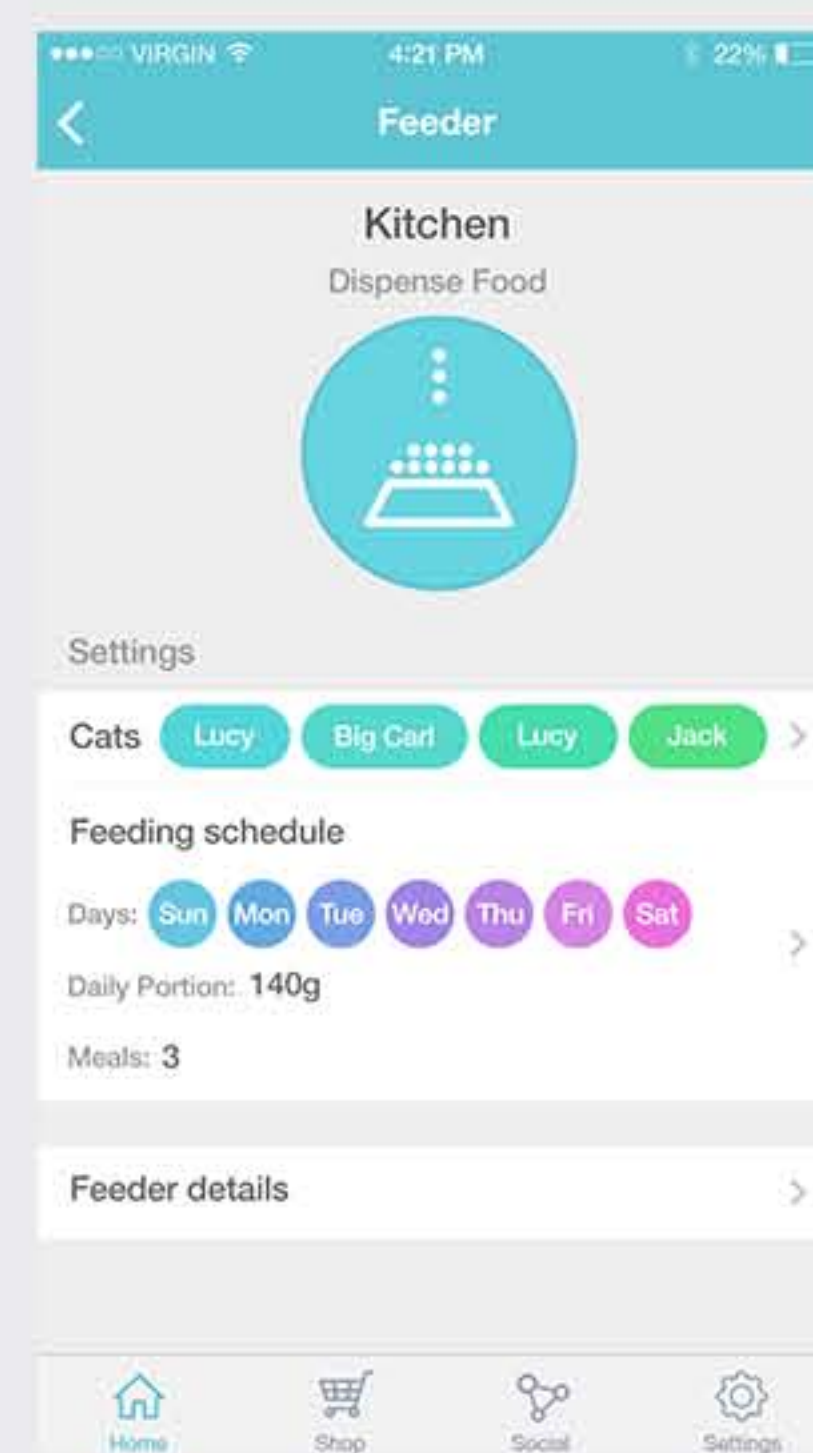
A. Manage your cats by tapping on the 'Cats' row. Fill their most recent physical details that you remember for more accurate meal portions calculation.



B. Tap on the 'Add New Cat' button to add your cats. It is recommended that you fill up

accurate information as much as possible, since age, breed, weight and gender affects the formula which is used for calculating your cats' meal portions. **Since each cat has its own health condition, it is recommended to consult a vet about daily food portion and modify it in the app manually.**



### 1 open an account

A. Install Cat2See app from the Google Play Store if you have an Android device. For Apple devices, install it from the AppStore. Finally launch the app.

B. Register a new account by tapping on the **Create one** button at the bottom.

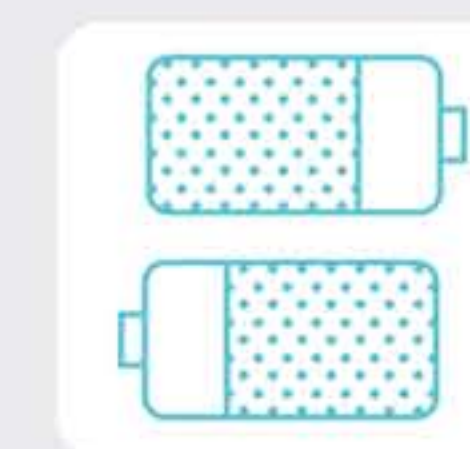

### 2 connect smart feeder

A. From the main screen, tap the 'Connect to Cat Feeder' button to start the wizard, then tap 'Next'.



B. Open the batteries cover and insert 4 AAA batteries into the battery compartment and close the plastic cover. Tap 'Next' to proceed.



C. Turn on the feeder by locating the power switch button at the back of the feeder. Then press and hold the button for 2 seconds until you see a blinking blue light. Tap 'Next' to proceed.



D. Make sure that only one (disconnected) feeder is turned on. If you have other feeders which you've already connected, it's ok, you can keep them turned on.

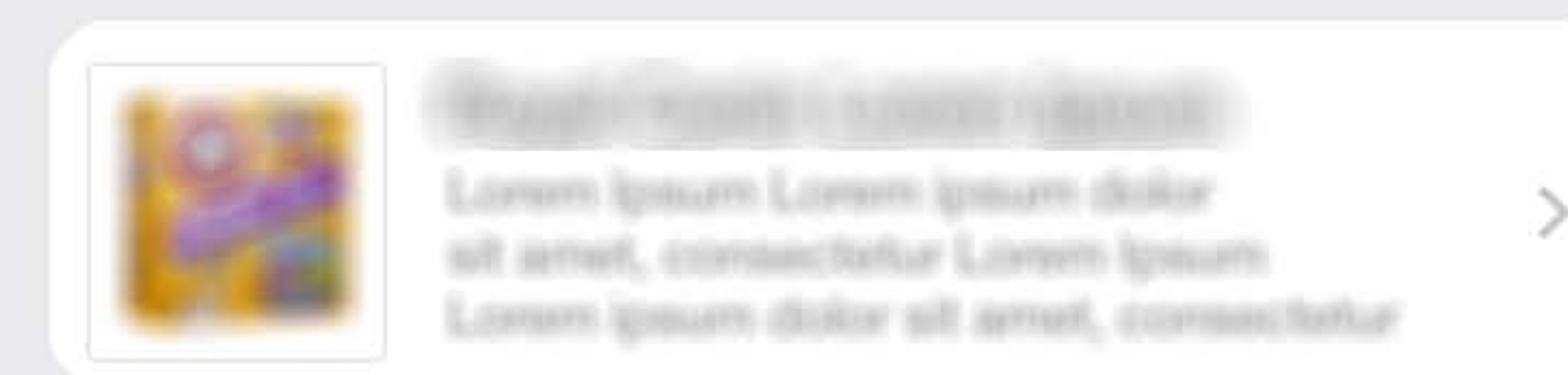


### 4 schedule daily meals

A. Choose which days of the week the feeder will dispense food. In addition, specify to how many meals the daily portion should be divided.

Feeding schedule  
Days: Sun Mon Tue Wed Thu Fri Sat >  
Daily Portion: 140g  
Meals: 3

B. You may pick from a list of food bags, the food that will be used with the feeder, in order to take into account calories / cup using the diet planner. Finally tap 'Save'



### 5 fill with dry food

A. Assemble the food container into the feeder body.

B. Fill the container with dry food and close the container with its cover.
