



MAIN CONTROL PANEL

- Bass Adjustment Press to enter Bass Adjustment Mode, then rotate right or left to adjust Bass settings (-6dB to +6dB).
- 2. Power/Mode / Volume Adjustment Press and hold for three seconds to turn Power On or Off. Rotate right or left to increase or decrease volume levels Press briefly to switch to Bluetooth mode.
- Treble Adjustment - Press to enter Treble Adjustment Mode, then rotate right or left to adjust Bass settings (-6dB to +6dB).






- 1, To connect to Bluetooth, turn on speakers, then press and hold the Power button to switch to Bluetooth mode.
- 2. Set your input device (mobile phone, tablet device, MP3/MP4 player etc.) to search for Bluetooth device and select "LUHSL20B".
- 3. Pair your device with "LUHSL20B".
- 4. Play the audio on your device and adjust the volume to a desired level.
- 5. To disconnect Bluetooth, press & hold the Power button.

SPEAKER PLACEMENT

Speaker Placement

Your **LUHSL20B** speakers can also be placed in many convenient locations in your home or patio area.

Wall Mounting

If hanging your speakers is desired, hang both speakers on a wall hook (not included) facing the listening area, this will provide the best audio results.

Do **NOT** mount speakers on wall surfaces that can get wet, or that have hazards concealed behind them, such as electrical wires or plumbing. Always mount speaker on surfaces that are sturdy enough to support the speakers' weight, and make sure they cannot fall or cause injury.

Experiment for Better Sound

You should experiment with various placements. Room acoustics can produce large apparent differences in the sound when small changes in the placement are employed.

For example, although the speaker may be located at any height above the floor, directing the tweeter toward ear level or angling the entire speaker toward the listening position often provides the most realistic imaging experience. The amount of bass perceived increases as you move a speaker closer to solid intersecting room surfaces (walls, ceiling, floor).

TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
No sound	Switch the speakers off, then reconnect the audio device.
	Make sure the master volume control knob on the back is turned up.
	Ensure the audio input is connected and that the input is set correctly on the speakers
	Ensure there is a signal from the audio source.
Cannot connect via Bluetooth	Ensure Bluetooth functionality is enabled and compatible on your Bluetooth device.
	Move the device closer, and retry the connection.
	Try another Bluetooth device for connection
Unit does not power on	Check to ensure power is connected and wall outlet is switched on.
	Switch the system off, then on, and reconnect to the audio source.
