

Wireless Charger Photo Frame




How to put in the photo?

- 1 Turn the clip (1) to unlock the back frame.
- 2 Insert your picture and turn the clip to lock the back frame.

- 3 Insert the USB cable into the charge hole.
- 4 Place your mobile phone on the front platform to charge your device . (wireless compatible only.)
