

Dear FCC,

Thank you for your inquiry. Originally it seemed the applicant intended that a number of different models be certified, some with and some without NFC. It was believed that the version without NFC would take precedence, and it was still yet to be determined if the NFC version included a modular NFC device or needed a new FCC ID. However due to the FCC's concern, we have had a significant amount of correspondence with both the lab and applicant regarding the models intended to be offered for sale. This has taken a while to sort out, as initially, inconsistent information was being provided to ACB.

After discussions and clarification, the applicant has since canceled all non-NFC models and desires to proceed only with the models that incorporate NFC using the current FCC ID. They have provided the necessary documentation for correction and we have now gone into the application and added the DXX equipment class, as well as the needed DXX EMC test report (after having reviewed it) and other revised exhibits needed to support the NFC functionality.

We have also communicated to our reviewers the need to always ensure that the device's capabilities as described in the documentation are fully tested and accounted for in the application uploaded and the final grant(s) issued.

Please let us know if these actions sufficiently address the FCC's concerns, or if you require any additional actions on the part of ACB.
