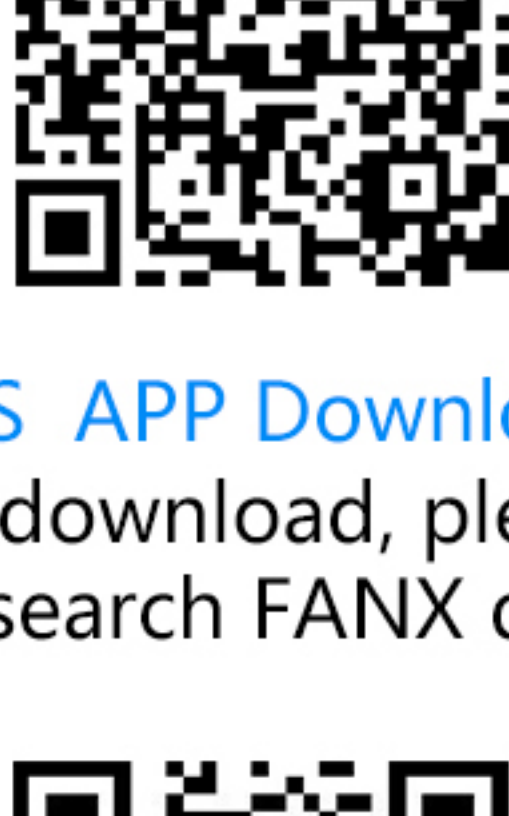

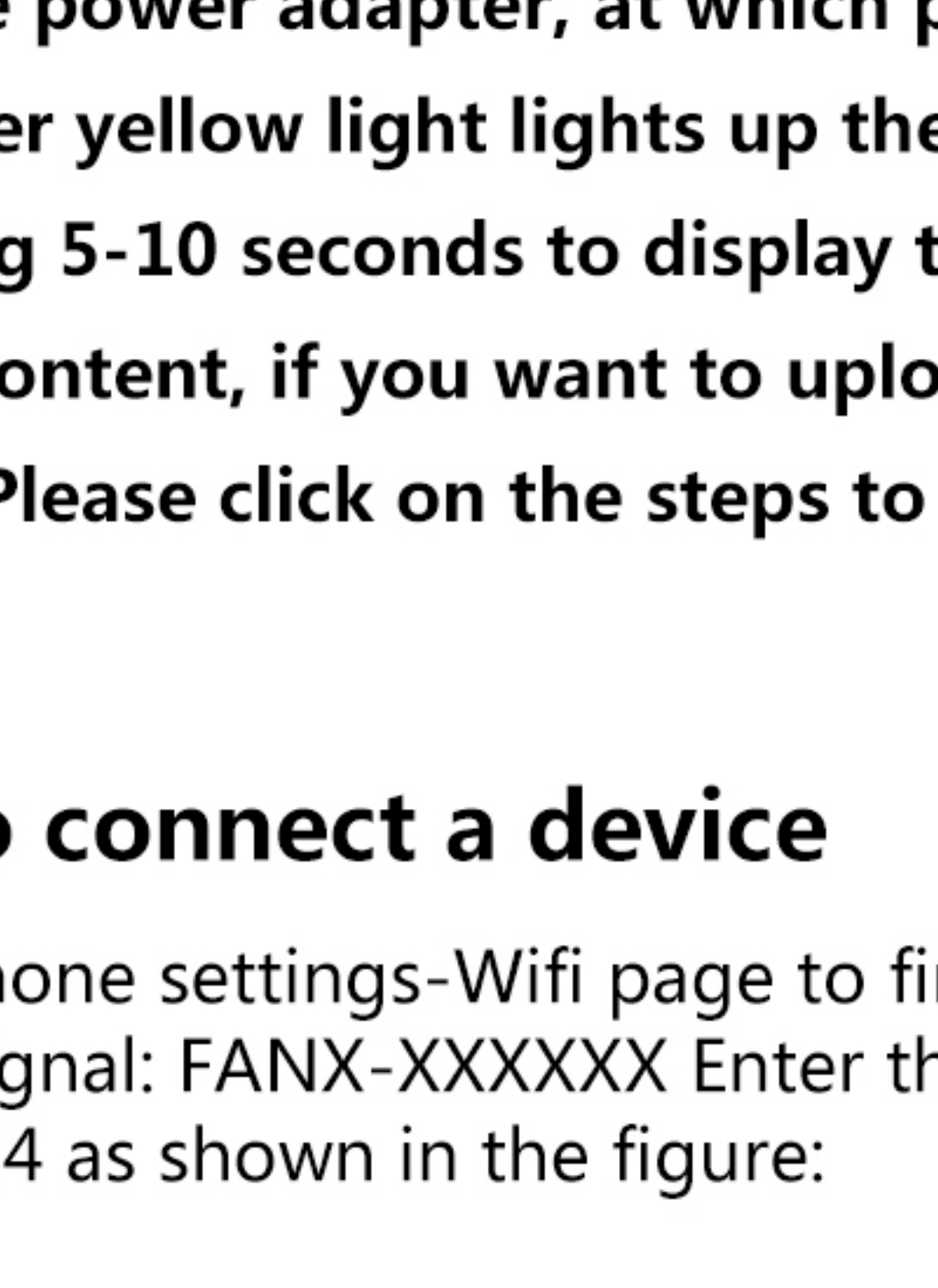


IOS APP Download

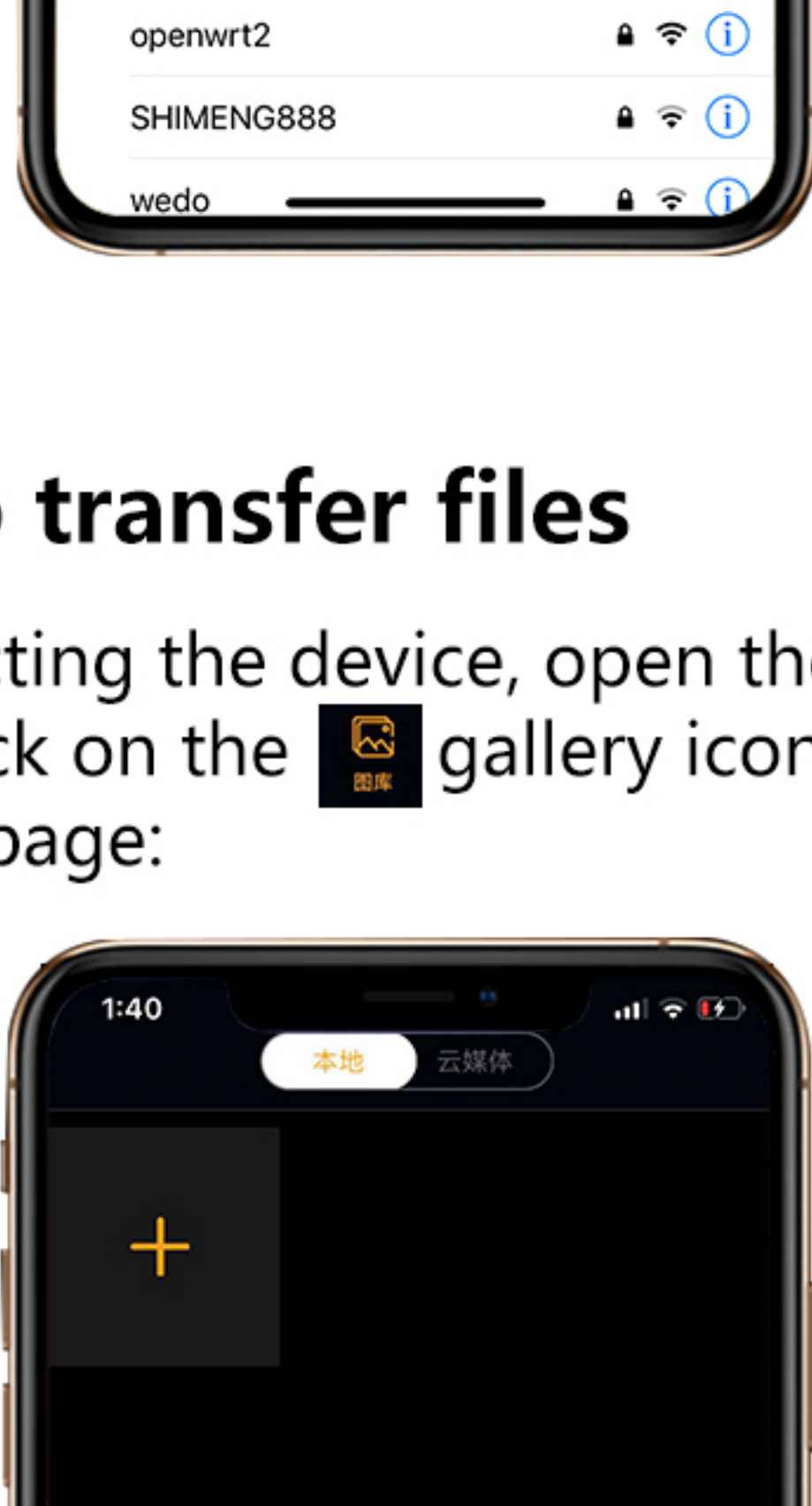
Android APP Download



Connect the power adapter, at which point the device center yellow light lights up the device after turning 5-10 seconds to display the device default content, if you want to upload your own video Please click on the steps to do the following:

1.How to connect a device

Go to the Phone settings-Wifi page to find the device WiFi signal: FANX-XXXXXX Enter the password: fanx1234 as shown in the figure:



2.How to transfer files

After connecting the device, open the FANX software and click on the  gallery icon below Go to the Gallery page:



Click on the top after entering the gallery page  Go to the editing interface. The editing interface can be scaled, moved, and other gesture operations to To move and zoom a picture or video to - make it complete in a circle. (After uploading the part outside the circle Device does not display) 。 Drag below  Can be truncated Take a section of the video:



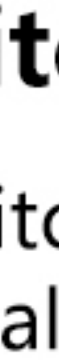

3.Edit and delete video files on your device

On the  Software Devices page , Slide the files in the file list to the left You can delete or edit a file.. Click Edit to change the name of the video file, the number of times it plays, and whether the action is displayed when the device plays.Press and tap the video and drag to adjust the order of playback.



4.Switch operating Equipment

The switch operation of a single device is The total switch above is a multi-operation Equipment.Click the Settings button , Enter the device setup interface for device modification Name, brightness adjustment, angle adjustment, mode switching, and can also be viewed within the device Storage, firmware information, and so on.
