





If you want to attach the parrot mouth accessory, use the magnet to adsorb the parrot mouth.






Replace Supplies







- Place Poooli as shown in figure 1, and look at the arrow.
- With reference to figure 2, push down the upper cover.
- When replacing supplies, place the supplies in reference to the direction shown in figure 3.
- If the supplies are properly placed, close the upper cover to the lower cover and push the upper cover back to its original shape.

⚠ When changing supplies , do not touch the print head in case of ovweheating.

Battery management and cautions

- When the charge is completed, please unplug the charging line.
- To avoid fire, do not charge at high temperatures(e.g. sweating rooms, bonfire accessories, etc.).



Charger attention

Print head management and cautions

- There may be damage to the print head due to improper charging.
- We recommend not to use Poooli L2 in high humidity or dusty areas.

Charging port damage phenomenon Charging cautions

 Please gently insert or unplug the chargingline to prevent excessive damage to the charging port.
