



# **Important Safety Instruction**

- •Do not block any ventilation openings. To ensure reliable operation of the projector and to protect from over heating, it is recommended to install the projector in a location that does not block ventilation. As an example, do not place the projector on a crowded coffee table, sofa, bed, etc. Do not put the projector in an enclosure such as a book case or a cabinet that restricts air flow. And clean all air filters once a month or clean when the air filters accumulate lots of dust
- •To reduce the risk of fire and/or electric shock, do not expose the projector to rain or moisture. Do not install near heat sources such as radiators, heaters, stoves or any other apparatus such as amplifiers that emits heat.
- •Do not let objects or liquids enter the projector. They may touch dangerous voltage points and short out parts that could result in fire or electric shock.
- •Do not use under the following conditions:
  - -- In extremely hot, cold or humid environments.
  - (i) Ensure that the ambient room temperature is within  $5^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 35^{\circ}\text{C}$
  - (ii) Relative humidity is  $10\% \sim 85\%$
  - -- In areas susceptible to excessive dust, dirt and fog
  - -- Near any appliance generating a strong magnetic field.
  - -- In direct sunlight.
- •Do not use the projector in places where flammable gases or explosives gases may be present in the atmosphere. The lamp inside the projector becomes very hot during operation and the gases may ignite and result in a fire.
- •Do not use the unit if it has been physically damaged or abused. Physical damage/abuse would be (but not limited to):
  - -- Unit has been dropped.
  - -- Power supply cord or plug has been damaged.
  - -- Liquid has been spilled on to the projector.
  - -- Projector has been exposed to rain or moisture.
  - -- Something has fallen in the projector or something is loose inside.
- •Do not place the projector on an unstable surface. The projector may fall over resulting in injury or the projector may become damaged.
- •Do not block the light coming out of the projector lens when in operation. The light will heat the object and my melt, cause burns or start a fire.
- •Please do not open or disassemble the projector without professional instructions as this may cause electric shock.
- •Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- •Do not look into straight into the projector lens during operation. The bright light may harm your eyes.

# **Important Safety Instruction**

- When turn on the projector, plug the power cord first before switch on the power switch to avoid short circuit.
- Turn off and unplug the power plug from the AC outlet before cleaning the product.
- •Use a soft dry cloth with mild detergent to clean the display housing. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes or solvents to clean the unit.
- •Disconnect the power plug from AC outlet if the product is not being used for a long period of time.
- Do not setup the projector in places where it might be subjected to vibration or shock.
- Do not touch the lens with bare hands
- Remove battery/batteries from remote control before storage. If the battery/batteries are left in the remote for long periods, they may leak.
- •Do not use or store the projector in places where smoke from oil or cigarettes may be present, as it can adversely affect the quality of the projector performance.
- Please follow the correct projector orientation installation as non standard installation may affect the projector performance.
- •Use a power strip and or surge protector. As power outages and brown-outs can KILL devices.

# **FAQ**

# Q: Bluetooth Delay

A: If play videos from online apps or from external devices, check the setting whether the player lets you de-sync the audio/video at the source to offset the delay. Media players on computer will do this (VLC,ect).

# Q: Cannot play videos while doing screen mirroring

A: This problem is due to DRM service, a copyright protection service, which will prevent video from playing while doing screen mirroring. Please play video from other apps that does not have DRM service or play downloaded local videos.

**Q:** Virtual Keyboard disappear or not pop up when log in Play store A: Please connect a keyboard to the projector to do the operation more easily.

# Q: Black Spot On Screen

- A:1) If it is small. it is a dust on the LCD screen inside, pat projector's upper cover several times, dust will fall down.
- 2) If it is large, the LCD screen may have damaged, please contact your seller, mainly by e-mail.

# Q: Auto turn off or only show the "android" logo then turn off

A: If meet such a problem, please contact your seller via email to ask for a firmware to reboot the android system, then the problem can be solved.

# Q: System Update

A: Android system on projector is different from system on phone and tablet, which does not support online update. Please DO NOT update the system on projector, even when any update message pop up, otherwise the projector may not work properly.

# Installation

### Q: No Sound

A: 1) DVD: Go to audio setting, change audio from auto to PCM.

- 2) Other devices (Fire stick or Apple TV ect.): Go to device's audio setting, switch off Dolby audio option.
- 3) If play video from USB, check if the video package DTS audio tracks, if so, change the video source.

# Q: How To Turn Off Internal Speaker

A: Press "Mute" button on remote or turn down projector volume to "1".

# Q: Connect Computer Via HDMI, But No Response

A:1) Windows PC: Go to "Setting"-- "Display" on your computer, select "copy these Displays".

2) Macbook: Go to "System preference" -- "Setting" -- "Arrangement", click the "Mirror Displays".

# Q: No Response When Connect Laptop using VGA Cable

A: When connect laptop using VGA cable, we may need to use Fn combination keys. Switch the projector to VGA mode, and then simultaneously press Fn key and screen projection key. The screen projection key may at different place in different brand laptops. It is possibly among F1 - F12. Please refer to your laptop's user manual.







### **Installation Method**

Please consult installation personnel for ceiling-mounted methods.

Follow the instructions below for the correct projector positions.





### Warning:

- 1. Please check the diagram below for vertical keystone correction.
- 2. This projector may be damaged beyond repair if it is incorrectly mounted on a ceiling or on a surface.
- 3. This projector should only be used in an environment where the temperature does not exceed the range of 5°C-35°C. Projector malfunction may occur if this is not adhered to.
- 4. Malfunction may occur if the projector is placed under dusty, wet, moist or smoky conditions.
- 5. Poor ventilation condition will cause overheating which may damage or even ruin the projector.


- Step1: Connect the projector and PC & laptop with VGA / HDMI cable.
- Step2: Choose "Multi-Media" on the top tap of the main interface.
- Step3: Choose "VGA / HDMI".

Step4: Adjust the PC display resolution to match the projector, such as 1024×768, 1280×800. If your PC and laptop is windows PC or laptop, press "Windows" & "P" buttons at the same time, select "Projector Only", you can adjust the PC display resolution.

Step5: If using VGA cable, you need to press specific keys on your PC. Normaly press "FN" & "F1~F12" simultaneously. (Because breands are different, please check with your PC supplier for the specific keys).

Step 6: Go to "Settings" on your PC, select "Displays", select "Duplicate These Displays" if using HDMI cable and the projector dose not recognize your PC.

Step7: If it doesn't work, turn off the projector and repeat above steps.











Launch EShare on your windows laptop, it will start to search for large display devices. Then click on the device which you want to connect to, and click on the start button the screen will be mirrored to your large display.






# **Image Adjustment**

Operating the projector for the first time, image may appear unclear or trapezoid, because the focus and keystone haven't been adjusted. Please do the following steps for correction:

### Focus adjustment


Turn the lens clockwise to the projector, and thereafter slowly turn it counter clockwise. At the same time, check the resolution point. The best position of the lens will be determined when the image is clear.





**Please note:** When moving the projector from a cold to a warm environment, water vapour may occur. Do not turn the projector on until such time as the vapour has disappeared.

### Keystone

If a projected picture has keystone distortion, correct the image with keystone adjustment. The image wil become a trapezoid shape when the screen or projector is not level. Please reposition the projector to improve its angle to the screen. However, the circumference of the image may not be focused.







If you are unable to use the keystone correction function to correct the trapezoid disortion, please lower the projector to the center of the screen vertically.

# **Turning On/Off**

### Turning on the projector:

1. Two new batteries should be installed into the remote control before use.



2. Plug power cable, turning on the power switch on the backboard, the indicator light will turn red.







Note: Suggest to plug the power cable first, then switch on power switch on the back. Otherwise it may cause short circuit.

3. Pressing the power key on the remote control or on the top panel, the indicator light will change to blue.





- 4. After a few seconds, the lamp will begin to work.
- 5. Using the projector for the first time, the image may appear blurry or distorted. Refer to the Image Adjustment chapter for instructions.

# Turning off the projector:

- 1. While using the projector, press the power key on the remote or projector to enter standby mode.
- 2. When the projector in standby mode, its auto protecting system will be activated. Press the power key to start up again.

### 4. Wireless Mirroring

Click on the 'Mirroring" button in EShare, the screen will be mirrored to your projector.



Eshare integrated annotation pen in the wireless mirroring function. After the mirroring mode is started, the pen will appear on the top right of the screen.





**Note:** When wirelessly mirror from your android phone to projector and play videos, video sound will not come from projector, only comes from your android phone.

You can connect a Bluetooth speaker to your android phone to get better sound.

With "TV Mirror" function, you can mirror the screen of the projector to android device and touch directly to control it









Press the direction key to select the "projection settings" in "Settings". The projection settings include Projection (image flipping function), Electronic Zoom and Four Points Trapezoid.

**Projection:** Front Mode / Back Mode / Invert Front Mode / Invert Back Mode.

Electronic Zoom: Adjustable range 75%-100%.

**Four Points Trapezoid:** four points of the picture can be adjusted manually from top to bottom, left to right.
