

Troubleshooting

Before resorting the maintenance service, please kindly check by yourself with the following chart

1. Power light is on. If it is not on, check the projector is plugged into the mains, that the socket is switched on, and then presses the power button on the projector. 2. Check the lens cover has been removed. 3. Check the cables are clearly attached and installed as per the User Manual. 4. The image source may not be correct. Press the Source button on the control panel. 5. Check in the menu section under Video input signal to make sure that has been set correctly.
Is the warning light indicator red? If so, the projector is over heating which turns off the light off automatically. 1. Leave the projector to cool for a few moments. 2. Once cooled, check nothing is blocking the ventilation vents.
The screen of the running projector is static, so it is easy to adsorb dust. Please turn off the projector. 1. Gently vibrate or shake the projector to remove dust. 2. In the air outlet of the projector, use the vacuum cleaner to absorb the inside of the projector, and suck the dust from the screen.
Check if the lens cover is removed, if not, remove it before using. Don't forget to cover it when not using.
Adjust the keystone, focus ring, and the projection distance.
Make sure your USB flash disk / TF card storage is not more than 32GB.

No sound	Turn off Dolby audio in your device. If the movie's audio is "ac3" (Dolby sound), then the sound may not be played (this kind of movie is very rare). Dolby, AC3 and stereo sound can not be decoded via the USB and SD ports. We recommend using the HDMI input. If you have no sound on the Fire TV Stick (APP: Netfix and Prime Video) due to HDCP, please turn off the Dolby sound and using other sound(Surround sound).
	If there is no sound from the stereo audio output when playing media contents from a set top box, BD/DVD or streaming players connecting to the HDMI input, please check the set top box or the player's digital audio settings and make sure it is set to "PCM Stereo" mode.
Connect the projector to your Smartphone/ iPad.	For Android device, you need a "Micro USB/Type C to HDMI cable" (Not included) For iOS device, you need a "lightning to HDMI cable" (Not included)
Bluetooth	The Bluetooth of the projector can only connect to the Bluetooth speakers, it cannot connect to the Bluetooth of the smartphone. A small number of models of Bluetooth speaker may not be compatible, please try other Bluetooth speaker.
TV Stick	Due to copyright issues, Netflix / Disney / Amazon prohibits playing movies directly from the projector. You can use a TV Stick to connect the projector to watch movies from Netflix, Hulu, and other similar services.
No Signal	When using HDMI to connect a TV or laptop to a projector, you need to select the input source as HDMI in the projector. If you use an HDMI cable to connect to the projector's HDMI1 port, you need to select the corresponding HDMI1 source interface in the projector.
Don't Work	Please take out the protection card inside before using the DVD.



Place your projector

Select location

You can decide where you want to install based on your room layout or personal preferences. Consider the size and position of the screen, the location of the appropriate power outlet, and the location and distance between the projector and the rest of the equipment. The projector can be installed in one of the following locations:




1. Front display on the desk

When this position is selected, the projector is placed directly in front of the screen. This is the most common way to place a projector, and it's fast and mobile.




2. Back display on the desk

When this position is selected, the projector is located directly behind the screen. Please note that you need a special rear projection surface.



3. Back to display by hanging

When this position is selected, the projector will be hung upside down on the ceiling directly behind the screen. Please note that this installation requires a dedicated rear projection screen and a ceiling mounting kit for the projector.




4. Front display by hanging

When this position is selected, the projector is hung upside down directly on the front of the screen. Acquire a special projector ceiling kit from your dealer to mount the projector to the ceiling.


Place your projector on the ceiling

- 1. When installing the projector in the ceiling, please purchase a projector bracket recommended by an installation professional and follow the instructions supplied with the bracket.
- 2.Before installing the projector on the ceiling, please check if the mounting structure can support the weight of the projector and the bracket. If in doubt please consult the advice of an installation.




Adjust the vertical position

Follow the picture below to adjust the vertical position.



To reduce image distortion

Measure the distance between the projector and the location where you want to position the screen. This is the projection distance.



Adjust the focus and keystone

Follow the picture below to adjust the focus and the trapezoidal screen.


Adjust the focus by turning the knob while observing the image pixels near the center of the screen. The optimal focus is achieved when the pixels are clearly visible.

Depending on the projected screen size, the focus near the edges of the screen may be less sharp than in the center of the screen.

FOCUS ADJ.KNOB




The keystone image is created when the projector beam is projected at an angle on the screen. The keystone correction returns the distorted image to a rectangular or square shape.




TRAPEZOIDAL ADJ.KNOB

Install / Remove the remote control battery





Remove the battery cover on the back of the remote control by gently pushing it open. The battery cover can then be raised. Insert the correct batteries (not included) according to the polarity markings. Finally, replace the cover.




- 1. Batteries must not be exposed to excessive heat, such as sunshine / fire.

- 4. Only use the same or equivalent batteries as recommended.



Install Power Adapter


Follow below picture to connect power adapter.

Connect small end of adapter FIRST. Plug the adapter body to power outlet.



Using Bluetooth Playback

Pairing is used when two Bluetooth devices are connected wirelessly for the first time. This allows the devices to see each other and sets up a one-to-one communication channel between both devices.

Bluetooth Connection:

- 1. Press the button to turn on unit.
- 2. Press the button to enter the menu screen.
- 3. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select right side menu.
- 4. Use the ▲ / ▼ button to select Bluetooth column.
- 5. Press the (OK) button to enter Bluetooth menu.
- 6. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select " ON"
- 7. Turn on your External Bluetooth Speaker and select to Bluetooth pairingmode.
- 8. A few seconds, you hearing "do" sound that your unit and external Bluetooth speaker connected.
- 9. After connection completed, the unit sound to External Bluetooth speaker.

Note:

- ① When the Bluetooth device can't connect to this projector automatically. Please enter to the Bluetooth setup menu and select, to the Bluetooth Reset to reset it, after that the BT device will be connected with this Projector automatically.
- ② Please make sure that Bluetooth is turned off when playing video from a PC via an HDMI cable. (Source-Setting Sound Bluetooth-Bluetooth Off)

Disconnect the Bluetooth

- 1. Press the button to enter the menu screen.
- 2. Use the \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright button to select above menu.
- 3. Use the ▲ / ▼ button to select Bluetooth column.
- 4. Press the OK button to enter Bluetooth menu.
- 5. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select " OFF" that the Bluetooth disconnect.


Bluetooth can not connect to smart devices with Bluetooth function, such as smartphones, laptops, and tablets. Only Bluetooth sound playback devices can be connected.

Connect HDMI

Follow below picture to connect HDMI cable and device.

- 1. Turn off the unit before connect HDMI cable.
- 2. After connect, press the 🐧 button to turn on unit and power indicator will light green.
- 3. Press the (SOURCE button to HDMI mode and the video of HDMI device will show on projector screen. There are 2 HDMI input, HDMI1 interface corresponds to HDMI1 in SOURCE mode, and HDMI2 interface corresponds to HDMI2 in SOURCE mode.


HDMI HD signal input: this interface can be input with HD player HDMI output at the connection



Connect AV

Follow below picture to connect AV cable and device.

- 1. Turn off the unit before connect AV cable.
- 2. Connect the end of 3 heads for both Female AV cable and Male AV cable together first, and then connect the other ends of Female cable to the AV IN of projector. Similarly, connect the other ends of male AV cable to the AV OUT of the DVD player or other Electronic device which supported AV out.
- 3. After connect, press the \bigcirc button to turn on unit and power indicator will light green.
- 4. Press the 2 /SOURCE button to AV mode and the video of AV device will show on projector screen.




Connected to the smartphone

To connect a tablet, Mac or smartphone, separate cables are required (Not in the package): Apple iOS device: Lightning to HDMI adapter

Google Android device: Micro USB/Type C to HDMI adapter

You can use a 3 in 1 smartphone to HDMI cable Adapter to link the device, if you have any problems and need help, please contact our customer service. (3 in 1 smartphone to HDMI cable Adapter is not included)



The approximate steps to connect your smartphone.


Before connecting, please make sure that the projector is not connected to the power supply to avoid damage to the device.


- 1) The HDMI connector of the HDMI converter is plugged into the HDMI1/ HDMI2 interface of the projector, and the other end is inserted into the data transmission interface of the smartphone.
- 2) Turn on the projector (when the device is abnormal, you should disconnect the power in time), press the power button on the machine or the power button of the remote control.
- 3) Start to enter the machine initial screen, to enter the homepage, press the "Source" button on the remote control to select the HDMI source (if the projector has multiple HDMI interfaces, please select the corresponding HDMI interface serial number, such as "HDMI 1")
- 4) After selecting the corresponding HDMI source, the screen of the projector and Smartphone are synchronized! The connection steps for the iPad are similar to connecting a smartphone.

Connect to Apple MacOS system computer

Connect to Apple MacOS system computer , separate cables are required (Not in the package):

The approximate steps to connect your Apple MacOS system computer Before connecting, please make sure that the projector is not connected to the power supply to avoid damage to the device.

- 1) The HDMI interface of the converter is plugged into the interface of the HDMI 1/ HDMI 2 projector, and the other end is plugged into the Type C or Mini Display Port of the computer.
- 2) Turn on the projector (when the device is abnormal, disconnect the power supply in time), press the power button on the machine or the power button to remote control.
- 3) Start to enter the initial screen of the machine, enter the home page, press the "Source" button on the remote control to select the HDMI signal source (if the projector has multiple HDMI HDMI interfaces, please select the corresponding HDMI interface serial number, such as "HDMI 1")
- 4) After selecting the corresponding HDMI source, the projector and Computer's screen are synchronized!

Connect PC/TV Box via HDMI / VGA interface

The steps are similar to connecting a smartphone, except that no extra converters are needed. Note: Please make sure that Bluetooth is turned off when playing video from a PC via an HDMI cable. (Source-Setting - Sound - Bluetooth-Bluetooth Off)

Problems when connecting smart devices

Dolby, AC3 and stereo sound can not be decoded via the USB and SD ports. We recommend using the HDMI input.



Connect VGA

Follow below picture to connect VGA cable and device


- 1. Turn off the unit before connect VGA cable.
- 2. Press the 🐧 button to turn off the power of your projector before connection.
- 3. After connect, press the 🙆 button to turn on unit and power indicator light GREEN,
- 4. Press the 📵 /SOURCE button to VGA device and VGA device will show on projector screen.



Connect Audio Output (Aux Output / Line Out / Headphone)


Follow the picture below to connect the device.

- 1. Press the 🐧 button to turn off the power of your projector before connection.
- 2. Use audio cable to connect follow below figure.
- 3. After connect and turn on both units. Your projector sound from external device now.
- 4. After using, turn off both unit.



Install USB Device and Micro SD Card

Make sure your USB flash disk / TF card storage is not more than 32GB. Follow the picture below to the USB and TF card Turn off the unit before installing USB / TF card



Using DVD playback

- 1. Press the 🐧 button to turn on unit and the power indicator light GREEN.
- 2. Press the 3/SOURCE button to enter and use 6 buttons to search the DVD mode.
- 3. Open the disc cover and insert a playable DVD or CD disc, make sure the label side is facing up, and then close disc cover.
- 4. The player will scan the disc, and then the playback will start automatically. If a disc menu appears on the screen, see "Using the disc menu" for details.
- 5. Press button to fast search forward and rewind.
- 6. Press 🕶 💌 button to search next or previous file.
- 7. During playback, press the 🔟 button to pause and press again to resume.

Disc handling:

- Do not leave discs near heat sources, in direct sunlight, or in high humidity.
- Store discs in their cases when they are not being used.
- Stacking discs or standing them at an angle without putting them in the case can cause the disc to warp.
- Do not touch the disc surface when handling a disc; hold it by the edges.
- Fingerprints, dust, dirt or scratches on the disc can distort the picture or reduce sound quality. Always handle carefully and make sure discs are clean before use.
- Do not stick paper or tape onto the disc.
- Do not write on the disc with a marker ,etc. Clean discs using a soft cloth, lightly wiping from the center outwards.
- Do not use solvents such as benzene, commercially available cleaner snot intended for CDs or anti-static spray intended for vinyl Ips, as these may damage your disc.







You must pay attention to the following points:

- 1. Place the DVD on the projector before turning it on.
- 2. Do not place the projector upright, as it will damage the DVD.
- 3. Do not support Blu-ray DVD.

Note: This DVD player has the function of direct continuous playback. However, there are also situations where the playback stop reading, you can refer to the following question to troubleshoot. There are many reasons why they stop reading, mainly due to disc problems:

- 1. The disc is scratched, the disc is not burned well, and the disc is not flat, which may cause the disc to stop reading. It is necessary for you to try to replace other DVD discs to test whether the same situation occurs.
- 2. The error correction function of the DVD player is impaired. DVDs have an automatic error correction function, which can make the discs with slight scratches and unevenness automatically correct and play normally, but the discs with serious problems cannot be corrected. If there is a problem with the error correction function, there may also be a problem with reading the disc. The error correction function alone is less likely to have a problem, because it makes the function on the motherboard chip, if the motherboard has a problem, the whole machine may not be able to play at all.
- 3. The DVD is not placed steadily. After a period of operation, the internal parts are worn out and cannot be played normally.
- 4. The projector can only be connected to a Bluetooth speaker, not a smartphone.
- 5. Due to copyright issues, Netflix / Disney / Amazon prohibits playing movies directly from the projector. You can use a TV Stick to connect the projector to watch movies from Netflix, Hulu, and other similar services.
