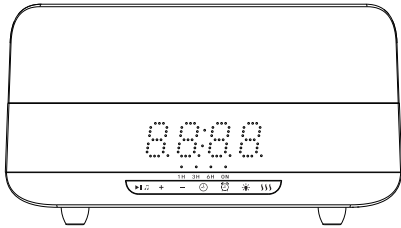
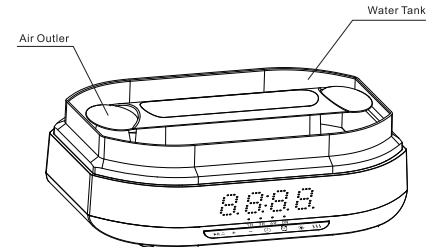
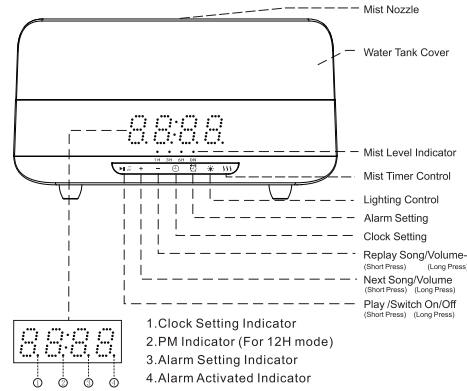


Flame Aroma Humidifier

USER MANUAL



Getting To Know Your Humidifier



Getting Started

1. Remove all packaging. Choose a solid, flat surface to place the humidifier. Place it at least 6 in / 15 cm away from any walls. The surface surrounding must be water-resistant
2. Make sure mist nozzle is directed away from walls, furnitures , beddings, and appliances.
3. Connect the power adapter to the base.

Diffusing Set Up

1. Remove the water tank cover.
2. Fill the tank with cool water. **DO NOT** fill with warm or hot water, **DO NOT** add water above indicating line.
3. Add 3-5 drops of Essential Oil (Optional)
4. Tip: When you briefly press the Spray / Timing " button to start the spray. Host default minimum spray mode. When you need more spray volume (you can press the Spray / Timing " button for more than 3 seconds in any current timing mode. The buzzer "drip" twice. In the middle fog mode, Press the "spray / timing" button again for more than 3 seconds. The buzzer will "drip" three times, Indicates as entering the dense fog mode
- 1) Press "spray / timing" button to open spray mode 1H (hour)
- 2) Press the secondary "spray / timing" button to open the spray mode 3H (hour)
- 3) Short press the "spray / timing" button three times to open the spray mode 6H (hour)
- 4) Short press the "spray / timing" button four times to open the spray mode ON (no timing / until automatic shutdown without water)
- 5) Press the "spray / timing" for five times short to close the atomization

Ambient Light Set Up

1. Short Press the light button Colorful gradient is enabled by default colorful gradient cycle-for 7 colour does not change color-green-highlighted green--red-highlighted in red-blue-highlighted blue-shallow blue-highlighting shallow blue-pink-highlight the pink-yellow, green-Gao Lianghuang green-white- bright white-out
3. Can be used individually as a night light, if turned on while using diffusing function, light will automatically turn off and stop together with mist once water level is low.

Clock Time Set Up

1. Press and Hold "Clock Setting" for 2 seconds , "Clock Setting Indicator" Starts to blink to enter 12/24H setting mode.
2. Quick Press the "Clock Setting" button again to set up Hour, Press "Alarm Setting" button to select the correct Hour.
3. Quick Press the "Clock Setting" button 3rd time to set up Minute, Press "Alarm Setting" button to select the correct Minute.
4. Quick Press the "Clock Setting" button 4th time to complete/confirm time set up.
5. Do Note that product will exit setting mode when left idle for 10 seconds.

Alarm Set Up

1. Press and Hold "Alarm Setting" for 2 seconds , enter alarm setting mode, "Hour" on display starts to blink
2. Press "Clock Setting" button to select the correct Hour.
3. Quick Press the "Alarm Setting" button again to set up Minute, Press "Clock Setting" button to select the correct Minute.
4. Quick Press the "Alarm Setting" button 3rd time to complete Alarm set up.
5. Press and Hold "Alarm Setting" to cancel alarm after entering alarm setting mode, "alarm activated indicator" goes off.

Bluetooth Speaker Set up

1. Press and Hold "Play/Stop" Button for 2 seconds to enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
2. Search for Device "H115A" in phone setting (keep your phone within 10m from speaker)
3. Choose song to play, short press "Play/Stop" button to stop or continue playing.
4. Short press +/- to play next song or replay
5. Press and Hold +/- to increase or decrease volume.

Care and Maintenance

You should clean your humidifier every week and when you are ready to store/keep it.

1. Unplug the humidifier and remove the power adapter from the base
2. Remove the water tank from the base. Pour out all water in the tank from the **MAX 400ml** direction
3. Use a cloth to clean the surface of the humidifier and the internals of the water tank, use a wet cotton bud to remove any remaining residue of essential oil on the diffusing nozzle.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Solution
Humidifier doesn't turn on	- Make sure the power adapter is correctly plugged into a working outlet. - Make sure the power adapter is correctly plugged into the humidifier base.
No mist comes out	- Fill up the water tank. - Clean and remove any residue/blockage on the diffusing nozzle with a wet cotton bud
Little Mist	- There may be too much water in the water tank. Empty and Refill the water tank with less water.(below max 400ml line) - Clean and remove any residue/blockage on the diffusing nozzle with a wet cotton bud - Make sure the air inlet on the bottom of the base is not blocked.
