



User Guide

1. APP INSTALLATION


(1) Scan the following QR code or search for "UBox" from the App Store (for iOS devices) or Google Play Store (for Android smartphones) to download and install the app.



2. APP REGISTRATION

(1) Open the app then press "Register". Choose "Email" then enter your Email address and press "Next".


(2) Enter the login password and confirm the login password then press "Next".



3. WI-FI CONNECTION

(1) We send a verify mail. Please open the mail and click the link to complete the verifications.

(4) Enter your Email address, **password**, **Phone number**, **City**, **Province** then press "Done".



4. USING THE APP

(1) Input the necessary information about your city, Province then press "Done".

(4) Press "Add a device" to add a smart device.



5. SPECIAL NOTES!

(1) The device has built-in WiFi receiver, WiFi module, LED indicator, Device E, WiFi receiver, WiFi antenna, and a speaker.

(2) If the device blue light is not blinking, please press the power/Call key to wake up the device. If the device blue light is still not blinking, please press the RESET button. The device will reboot and enter the pairing mode.



6. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

(1) Set the device name and select the device location before the set-up.



7. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

(1) Notes about WiFi receiver: WiFi can charge the WiFi receiver battery when the device is connected to a power source. Device D or "User" to reduce WiFi receiver battery consumption.
