① open the battery cover on the back of the wireless terminal.

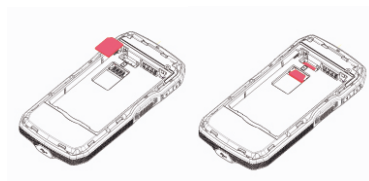


② Remove the battery

③ Insert the SIM card into the SIM socket.

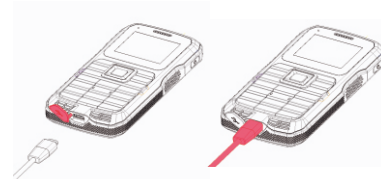


④ Put the battery and battery cover back in place.

RF Exposure Information and Statement
