


Quick Getting Started



Attention

1. All operations will auto-exit and save settings if there is no operation within 5 seconds.
2. Please check the "AM" & "PM" indicators when you set the time and alarm.
3. Please keep plugged in !


Top View

Time Setting



- ① Press “ 

Example: The default time is “AM 12:00”, but the correct time is “AM 12:30”.
Correct the minute as below.

Alarm Setting



- ① Press “ 

Notice:

1. Make sure you have set the FM radio channel before choose radio alarm ringtone.
2. The P06 ringtone is the last played FM radio channel.

Alarm Pause /Snooze



- ① Press “ 

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Notice:

1. The “  ” icon will blink as you press the snooze, and it won’t blink when you stop the alarm.
2. If you do not press any button, the alarm will last for 10 minutes.

Alarm On/Off



Long press “  ” for 2s to turn on or off the alarm. If the “  ” icon displays, it means the alarm is on. Otherwise, the alarm is off.

FM Radio Setting

FM



Please extend the FM antenna on the back of the machine.

① Turn ON/OFF: press “ FM ”.

② Adjust volume: Scroll “ +  - ” (U00-U30).

Manual Tune FM Channel



Press “◀” / “▶” to tune radio frequency and long press “◀” / “▶” to tune quickly .

Auto Search FM Channel



- ① Long press "FM" 2 secs to start auto-search.
- ② During the search, channels are saved automatically.
- ③ Once the station search is completed, press "FM" to select the saved radio station.


Once auto search is completed, but you want to manual tune FM Channel, please RESTORE FACTORY SETTING.

Wireless Speaker Setting



- ① Turn on: press “ ” .
- ② Connect: when the “ BT ” flashes, search and select R9BT-RA from the device list to connect.
- ③ Switch music: press “ ” / “ ” .
- ④ Adjust volume: scroll “ ” (U00-U30).
- ⑤ Play/Pause: press “ ” .
- ⑥ Turn off: long press “ ” for 2s(“ BT ” will disappear).

Connect Wireless Speaker:



Notice:

1. The wireless speaker function is only for music play, not for phone calling.
2. The time will auto-sync when connected to your phone.
3. If the connection is successful, "BT" icon will continuously display on the R9BT-RA.

Auto-off Timer Setting



When the radio/wireless speaker is playing, press “  ” to preset duration to auto-turn off.

- ① Turn on: press “  ” (repeatedly press to select time).
- ② View Remaining Duration: press “  ” during the timing process.
- ③ Select Options: 30min-1H-2H-OFF.

Display Dimmer Setting



Scroll the “ +  - ” to brighten/dim the display brightness.

Wireless Phone Charging



Place your phone horizontally on the phone wireless charging area. The magnetic alignment function will automatically attach the phone, keeping it in the correct position.

Notice:

1. Please charge with a bare phone or phone with a metal-free & less than 3 mm thick phone case.
2. The magnetic alignment experience only applies to iPhone 12,13,14 and 15. Equipped with MagSafe case, its magnetic alignment function will be better.

Restore Factory Setting



Simultaneously hold “◀” and “☒” for 2s to restore factory settings.

Safety Instructions
