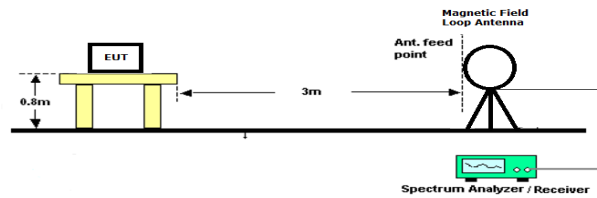

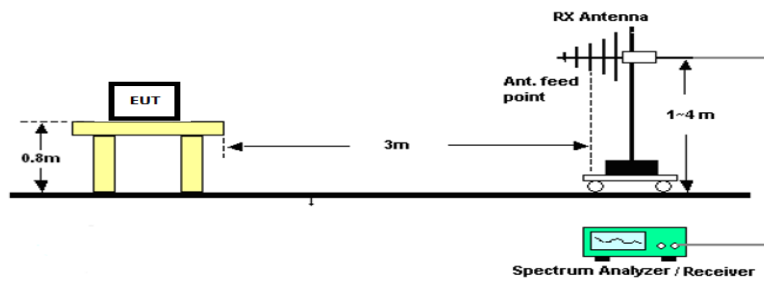

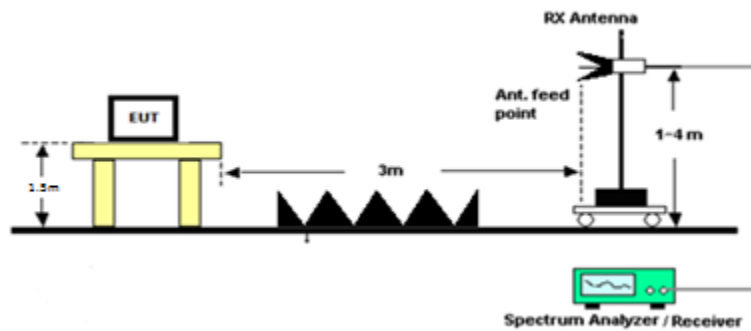
Radiated Test Setup, Below 30 MHz
