

- 1 . Insert SIM card before power on system .The right direction and way. It support standard SIM card format (Micro SIM card and Nano SIM card need ferrule support, Local operators can provide and solve).
- 2 . Click "Mobile network" to access to settings.
- 3 . Switch on mobile data toggle and network type.

Bluetooth connection

- 1. Click settings icon to access to "Connected devices" menu.
- 2 . Click" Connection preferences" into "Bluetooth" icon and slide right button .Turn on / off .
- 3 .Click "Device name" icon, can be rename this device.
- 4 . Click "Pair new device "icon ,Bluetooth and system will automatically search the Bluetooth devices and Available device nearby.
- 3 . Click on the connectable Bluetooth device then select "Match or Pair" In pop up menu ,have bluetooth pairing code.
- 4 . Wait for the Bluetooth device to confirm the connection

Screen settings

Click settings to access to Display menu

- 1. Brightness level: Scroll the bar to control the screen brightness
- 2 . Eye comfort : Click "Schedule" can be custom turn on time . Click "TURN ON NOW " can be into eye comfort ,"Intensity" Scroll the bar to control the screen intensity. Click "TURN ON NOW " again ,closed "Eye comfort".

*Eye comfort tints your screen amber ,This makes it easier to look at your screen or read in dim light ,and may help you fall asleep more easily.

- 3. Colors & contrast: have "Warm"/"Standard"/Cool" screen chroma.
- 4. wallpaper: set the wallpaper content and choice wallpaper from.
- 5. Sleep(Screen timeout): set the screen lock time.
- 6 . Font size : set the size of font. Children and the elderly, please try to use larger size, so that they can take care of their eyesight and easy to use.
- 7 . Auto-rotation : lock the screen direction or let device to automatically rotate screen based on the direction
- 7 .Display size : set the size of APP icon and display. Children and the elderly, please try to use larger size, so that they can take care of their eyesight and easy to use.

Audio settings

Click settings to access to "Sound or Audio profiles " menu

- 1 . Volume : Scroll the bar to adjust the volume of media , alarm and ringtone(or click system—Volumes).
- 2. Notification sound: select notification sound
- 3. General-Edit(or phone ringtone SIM1 and SIM2): select incoming call

ringtone . Other sounds : Turn on / off screen lock touch sound effects

Battery status

Click settings to access to "Battery" menu , battery usage can be viewed in here.

Power display: turn on / off Battery percentage display

Connect to PC

Device can be connected with PC via USB cable to perform copy delete actions

- 1 . Operating system including Windows 7 and above version will automatically install MTP drivers when device connecting to PC at first time
- 2 . For Windows XP , Windows Media Player 11 must be installed before connecting device to PC
- 3 . Slide down the upper left screen notification bar . Click Android System-Charging this device via USB. Have option —Contact as —"Charge only"-"Media device (MTP")-"Camera(PTP)" and more .

Application management

Click "settings" to access to "Apps & notifications" menu to perform . Click "See all apps". Actions" including "UNINSTALL" ,"FORCE STOP" (or "OPEN").

Language and input

Click settings to access to "System" menu

Date & time

- 2 . Select "Automatic time zone "to let system to sync the local time zone when connecting to internet . You can manually adjust the time zone by turning off this function
- 3 .Time format : Automatic 24-hour format (Use locale default) or Use 24-hour format . choose the 12-hour or 24-hour display format.

USB OTG function

USB OTG function can be used to exchange data with other portable device (flash drive , mobile hard disk , 3G dongle , mouse and keyboard

- 1. Devices need to be connected to this product via OTG cable
- 2 . Please keep device power above 50% while using OTG function ,separated power supply is needed for high-power consumption devices.

Storage

Click settings to access to "Storage "select menu

- 1 .Display device total storage space and Used of storage.
- 2 .View the storage space occupied by files and systems
- 3 .FREE UP SPACE : Click it, into Remove items(or REVIEW RECENT ITEMS), Select Applications that need to be removed. Choice "FREE UP".—"FREE UP SPACE".
