

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Installation Method 1:

(as shown in Figure 1) Paste the magic tape on the back of the boxing target and the flat wall, align the magic tape, and install the boxing target on the target position. Note that the charging port should not be more than 1.5 meters away from the socket.



Installation Method 2:


(as shown in Figure 2) Put the back suction cup into the bayonet position and press it tightly. Press the boxing target hard to adsorb it on the target position until the air in the middle of the suction cup is drained and let go. Please select the wall to attach to the tile. Note that the charging port should not be more than 1.5 meters away from the socket.

Tips: Dip a little water into the suction cup when installing it, it will make the suction cup more tightly! If you do not use it for a long time, remove it in time to avoid falling off and being hurt.

Boxing is a combat sport in which two boxers strike each other with gloved fists. It is both an amateur activity and a professional sport.

In boxing training, boxing targets are usually used to train the speed and strength of the players, because the opponent's gap is fleeting during boxing matches, compared with strength training, it is more important to train the players' offensive and defensive response ability.

The product trains people's reaction ability through electronic control of light guidance, and determines whether it is accurately hit on the target point through sound prompts, so as to effectively exercise people's overall coordination and reaction ability.

BASE VERSION


- SPEED BUTTON:
 Tap to switch three speeds
- SWITCH BUTTON:
 Long press the switch, short press pause
- AUDIO BUTTON:
 Long press to mute,
 short press to switch three volumes



BLUETOOTH VERSION Tips: Bluetooth name (quanji)

- SPEED BUTTON: Long press to disconnect bluetooth, short press to switch three speeds
- SWITCH BUTTON: Long press the switch, short press pause
- AUDIO BUTTON:
 Long press to connect bluetooth,
 short press to switch three volumes
