2.3 Specific operational use conditions

2.4 Limited module procedures

This device is only approved for integration with Zipline host devices.

2.5 Trace antenna designs

Not applicable.

2.6 RF exposure considerations

This equipment complies with FCC radiation exposure limits set forth for an uncontrolled environment. This equipment should be installed and operated with a minimum distance 20 cm between the radiator & your body.

2.7 Antennas

The device is only authorized for use with the antennas and installation as described in the Operational Description. Other types of antennas or installation may require additional authorization for operation.

2.8 Label and compliance information

The host product manufacturers must provide a physical or e-label stating "Contains FCC ID 2BML6P2EV1-0" with their finished product. See Guidelines for Labeling and User Information for RF Devices – KDB Publication 784748.

2.9 Information on test modes and additional testing requirements

The device should be tested as installed in the host device to comply with radiated spurious emissions (15.205, 15.209), band edge (15.247(d)) and for worst case mode (802.11n, MIMO).

2.10 Additional testing, Part 15 Subpart B disclaimer

The module is certified for Part 15 Subpart B. The host device shall be verified to comply with Part 15 Subpart B with the module installed per the Operational Description.

2.11 Note EMI Considerations
