



# JUKEBOX

**For the delight and amusement of all people age 14 and over. For indoor use only.**

## A. OPERATION

1. Open the battery compartment cover and insert 3 x AA batteries (included) into the battery compartment. Align "+" and "-" as marked on the battery compartment.
2. Close the battery compartment cover.
3. Turn the Volume knob switch to ON
4. Press the song button on the front panel to select a song. The music stops after the selected song plays.
5. Press and hold "Bluetooth" button for 3 second, will start "Bluetooth mold", find the equipment "Mr, Christmas Jukebox" and connected to play song.
6. During the Bluetooth Mold, Press and hold "Bluetooth button" for 3 second, will come back to music mold.
7. Adjust volume by pressing the Volume Up or Volume Down on the front panel.
8. The jukebox lights up when the song is played both music mold and bluetooth mold.
9. Turn to the "OFF" position to turn off the Jukebox.

### Remarks

Under music mode: music stops after 30s, lights will OFF, Jukebox in STANDBY mode.

Under Bluetooth mode: songs from computer/ mobile stop after 30s, lights will OFF, Jukebox in STANDBY mode.

Under Bluetooth mode: Computer/ mobile OFF suddenly, Bluetooth mode will be CUT OFF, after 30s lights will OFF, Jukebox in STANDBY mode.

## C. TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	LIKELY CAUSE	SOLUTION
Songs not playing	Batteries not inserted correctly	Make sure to align the "+" and "-" as marked on the battery compartment
	Switch is in the "OFF" position	Turn the switch to from OFF to ON position
	Batteries exhausted	Change to new batteries

## D. CARE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do not expose this item to moisture or outdoors. This item is for indoor use only.
2. Before using or reusing, inspect product carefully. Discard any products that have cracks in enclosure or exposed wire.
3. When storing the product, carefully remove from the current location to avoid any undue strain or stress on the conductors, connections and wires.
