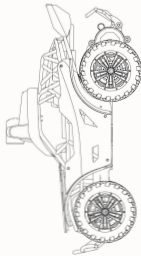

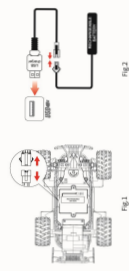

4. BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Open the battery cover on the back of the remote control car and remove the battery cover.
- Connect the USB charging cable to the corresponding socket. During charging, the LED indicator will light up.
- Insert the battery pack into the battery case, connect its terminals, replace the battery cover, and secure with a screwdriver.

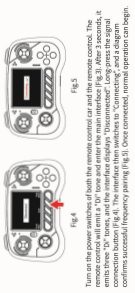
2. REMOTE CONTROL CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

Connect the charging cable to the port on the remote control car and the opposite end plug into the remote control's socket. When charging is complete, the indicator turns off.



4. LINKING INSTRUCTIONS

Press the power button on the remote control car and the remote control. The operator can use the remote control to transmit the voice to the remote control vehicle, and then the remote control can control the car's operation.

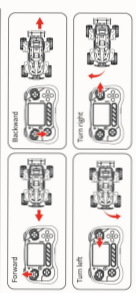


6. OPERATING GUIDANCE

6.4 Lens adjustment: Press the camera angle fine-tuning buttons on the remote control to adjust the lens angle as required (Fig. 11).
