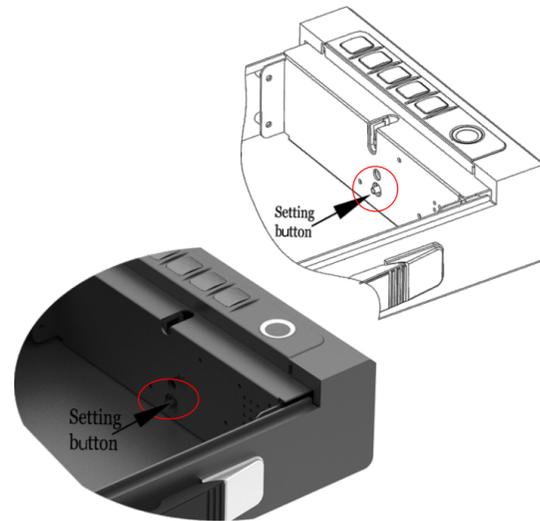


How to set the Smart Safe Box

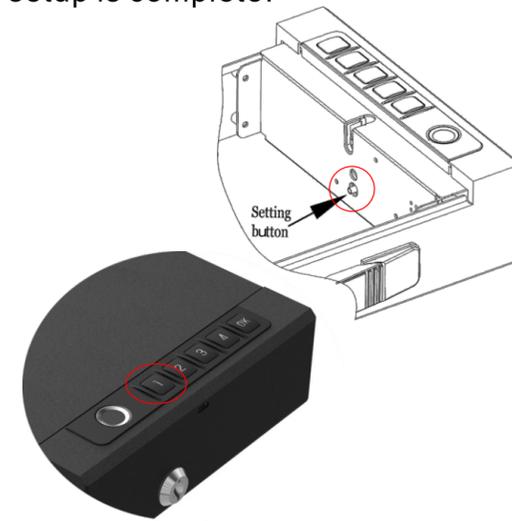
1. Use the enclosed key to open the safe box (Note keep the key outside the safe box).



2. Long press the safe setting button, After hearing the voice prompt, enter the 6-digit password and press the OK button to confirm. Enter twice to confirm the password is set successfully.



3. Press button 1 briefly, then press and hold the setup button. Upon hearing the voice prompt, begin fingerprint enrollment. Continuously scan your fingerprint six times consecutively until a success notification confirms the setup is complete.



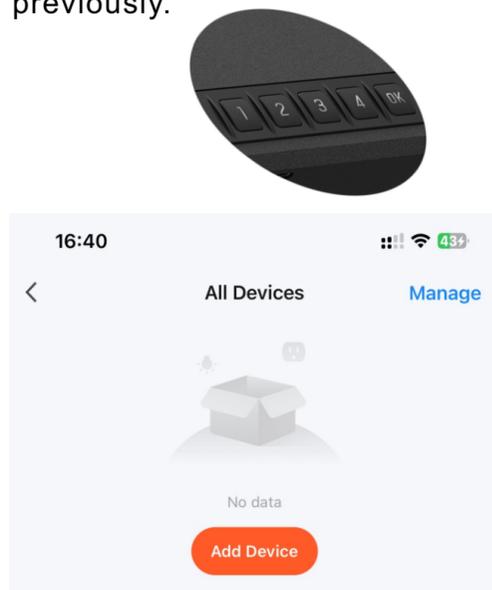
4. Long press Button 1 to turn on or off the key sound, Long press button 4 to turn on or off the alarm sound.

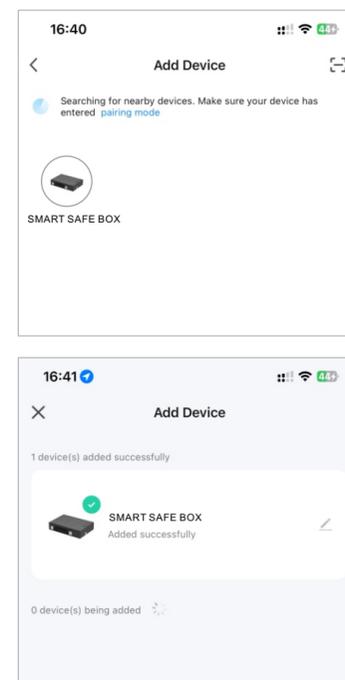
1. Scan the QR code below and install the APP.



2. Open the "Tuya" app (make sure the phone's Bluetooth is turned on), long press the machine's 2 button, wait for the light to flash, and enter the 6-digit password you set previously.



3. Click "Add Device" in the interface, you will find "Smart Safe Box" and click to add.



4. After adding, it shows that the connection is successful, and you can open the device by sliding the unlock button below.
