#### 5.1.1. Antenna Requirement

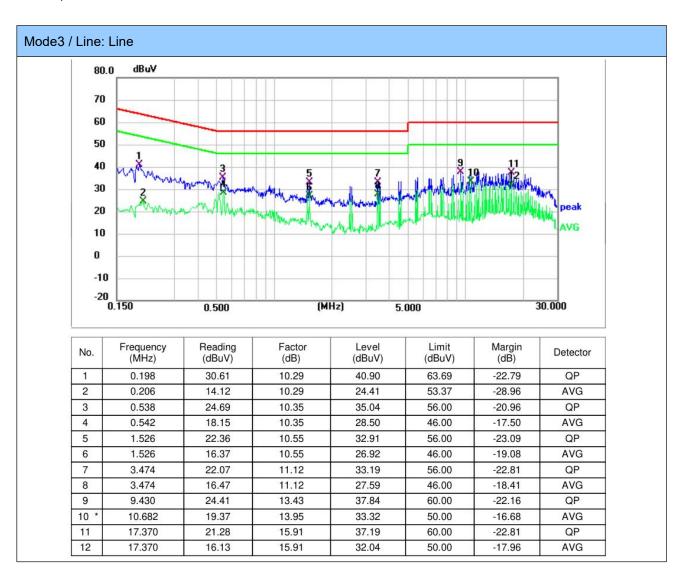

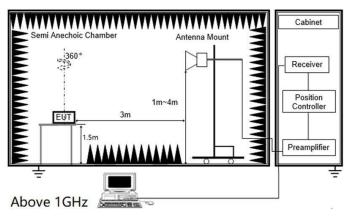

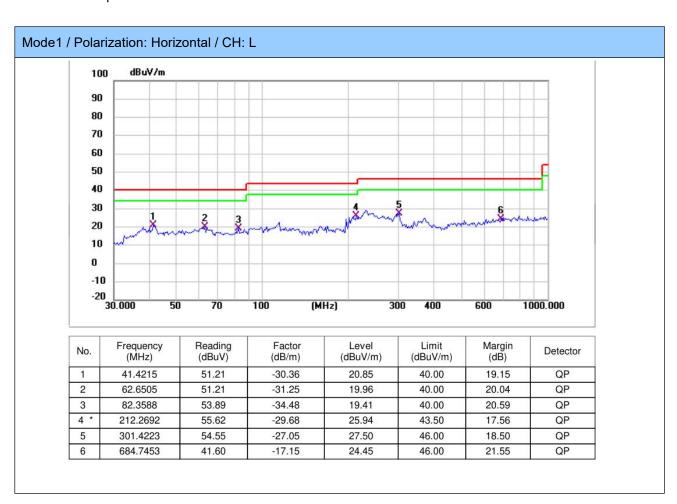
