



During the conducted emission test, the host PC was connected to the outlet of the first LISN and the other support equipments were connected to the outlet of the second LISN.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions of the EUT.

All final data was recorded in the Quasi-peak and average detection mode.





The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters chamber test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.4-2009. The specification used was the FCC Part 15.109 Class B limits.

The external I/O cables were draped along the test table and formed a bundle 30 to 40 cm long in the middle.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

The host PC was connected to a 120 VAC/60 Hz power source.

# **EMI Test Receiver Setup**

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 6 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the EMI test receiver was set with the following configurations:

#### **Test Procedure**

For the radiated emissions test, the host PC was connected to the first AC floor outlet and the other support equipments were connected to the second AC floor outlet.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

All final data was recorded in the Quasi-peak detector mode from 30 MHz to 1 GHz and PK and average detector modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.
