RE: Application for Limited Modular Approval Certification for the BM-GP-BR-51 Bluetooth Module

Dear Sir or Madam:

The following information addresses the requirements to support a limited modular approval as required by the FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 "Part 15 Unlicensed Modular Transmitter".

1	The modular transmitter is equipped with shielding to cover the RF section.
2	All inputs to the modular transmitter are buffered through logic or microprocessor inputs.
3	The modular transmitter has its own power supply regulator. The module will be integrated in the ML910 which also offers power supply regulation.
4	The ML910 has a Bluetooth antenna that complies with section 15.203 of the FCC rules. The antenna is an SMT table top form factor antenna permanently mounted to the module.
5	The modular transmitter has been tested standalone. It has also been tested internal to the ML910. It will always be integrated internal to the ML910.
6	The modular transmitter will be labeled as required. The ML910 will also be labeled as required.
7	Operational requirements have been added to the manual (refer to the User's Manual).
8	MPE measurements are provided to demonstrate RF compliance for mobile limited modular approval. There will be a cautionary statement added to the manual stipulating the 20 cm separation distance (refer to the User's Manual).
