Exhibit A : FCC Part 15. 233 Cordless Telephone Basic Information Sheet

A-1 : In addition to other label requirements, the following statement shall be placed in a conspicuous location on the cordless phone :

This equipment complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions : (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

"Privacy of communications may not be ensured when using this phone"

A-2 : The following (or similar) statement should be included in the Use/Instruction Manual Information :

Changes or modifications not expressly approved in writing by {insert company name} may void the user's authority to operate this equipment.

A-3 : For cordless phones operating on channel 1-15, the box or instruction manual which is included within the box which the individual cordless phone is to be marketed shall carry the following (or similar) information :

Some cordless phones operate at frequencies that may cause interference to nearby TV's and VCR's ; to minimize or prevent such interference, the base of the cordless telephone should not be placed near or on top of a TV or VCR; and, if interference is experienced, moving the cordless telephone farther away from the TV or VCR will often reduce or eliminate the interference

A-4 : For cordless phones do not comply with FCC 15.214(d) digital security code requirements, the box or other package in which the individual cordless phone is to be marketed shall carry a statement in a prominent location, visible to buyer before purchase, which reads as follows :

NOTICE : The base units of some cordless telephones may respond to other nearby units or to radio noise resulting in telephone calls being dialed through this unit without your knowledge and possibly calls being misbilled. In order to protect against such occurrences, this cordless telephone is provided with the following features : (to be completed by the responsible party),
