I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that the bottom of the device appears to be more than sufficiently large to contain the 2-condition statement as required by 15.19. Please note that this 2-condition statement does not have to be part of the FCC ID label and can be on its own label. Please note that as the bottom of the device appears sufficiently large to contain a label, either as part of the FCC ID label or on a separate label, unless the label would cover air holes etc, the exclusions of 15.19(a)(5) would not appear to apply. Please either provide an adequate reason why this statement cannot be on the device or please provide a sample label showing this 2-condition statement.
2. Please provide the required internal photos.
3. Please provide the required manual with all appropriate FCC statements.
4. Please explain the function of the "Wireless Key". Is it a transceiver, a transmitter, a receiver only? What function does it have in relation to the shown EUT and how do they work together? While it may be assumed to be part of an RFID/security system, the function needs to be explained adequately. Please provide an explanation as to this key and its function in relation to the transmitter.
5. Please note that required frequency variations due to temperature must be measured in accordance with 2.1055. This means that data must be provided for every 10 degrees from the lowest temperature to the highest temperature stated. Please provide temperature testing in accordance with the requirements of 2.1055(b).
6. Please note that 15.225 also requires frequency stability testing in relation to the supply voltage. Please provide this data.
