Motorola Inc., 8000 West Sunrise Blvd., Fort Lauderdale, Florida, herein submits application for Certification of the equipment identified by the number FCC ID: AZ492FT1630.

This transmitter is primarily intended for use in a mobile radio application with capabilities for conventional communications with a conducted transmit power which is adjustable from 50.0 Watts (+46.99 dBm) to 132.0 Watts (+51.21dBm).

This is a LB mobile two-way radio that operates using analog frequency modulation (FM) incorporating traditional simplex transmission protocol (50% Duty Cycle) and may be marketed to and used by employees for occupational operations, such as Federal and Public Safety agencies, e.g. police, fire and emergency medical, etc.

The subject transmitter complies with CFR Title 47, Section 90.203, in that the operator cannot directly program the transmit frequencies using only the normally accessible external controls of the unit.
