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1 General Information

1.1 Scope

Applicable Standards:

This test report addresses the intentional radiated emissions requirements per FCC 15.247, which are the harmonic/spurious radiated emissions occurring in the restricted bands per FCC 15.205 (against the FCC 15.209 limits).

1.3 Test Facility

The open area test site and conducted measurement facility used to collect the radiated data is located at 360 Herndon Parkway, Suite 1400, Herndon, Virginia 20170. This site has been fully described in a report and approved by the Federal Communications Commission to perform AC line conducted and radiated emissions testing (ANSI C63.4 2003).

1.4 Modifications

No physical modifications were required for compliance. Power levels were reduced to pass band edge testing, using supplied firmware which was uploaded to the device.

2 Test Information

2.1 Description of Test Modes

In accordance with FCC 15.31(m), and because the EUT utilizes an operating band greater than 10 MHz, the following frequencies were tested:

2.2 Exercising the EUT

The EUT was tested in all three orthogonal planes in order to determine worst-case emissions. The EUT was provided with software to continuously transmit during testing. The carrier was also checked to verify that information was being transmitted. There were no deviations from the test standard(s) and/or methods. The test results reported relate only to the item tested.

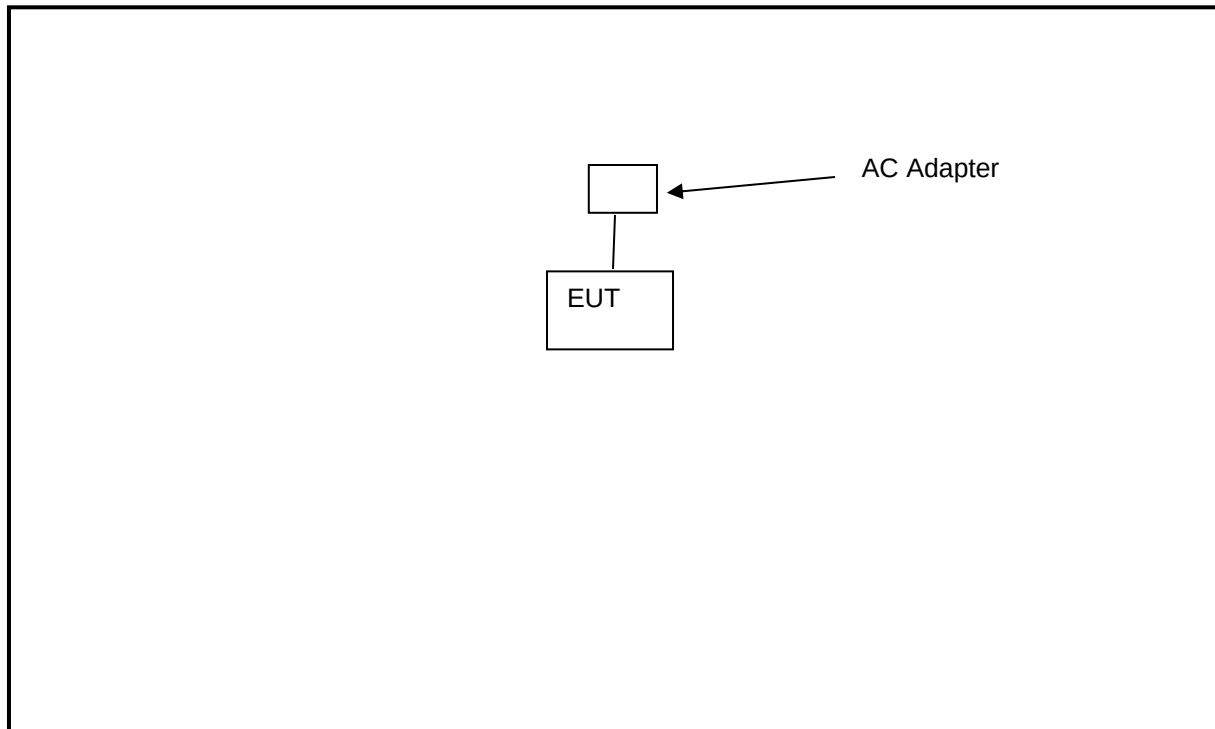

3.1 Limits of Radiated Emissions Measurement

As shown in 15.35(b), for frequencies above 1000 MHz, the field strength limits are based on average detector, however, the peak field strength of any emission shall not exceed the maximum permitted average limits, specified above by more than 20 dB under any circumstances of modulation.

3.2 Radiated Emissions Measurement Test Procedure

Procedure: C63.10-2009 6.5, 6.6

Before final measurements of radiated emissions were made on the open-field three/ten meter range, the EUT was scanned indoors at one and three meter distances. This was done in order to determine its emissions spectrum signature. The physical arrangement of the test system and associated cabling was varied in order to determine the effect on the EUT's emissions in amplitude, direction and frequency. This process was repeated during final radiated emissions measurements on the open-field range, at each frequency, in order to ensure that maximum emission amplitudes were attained.

Final radiated emissions measurements were made on the three/ten-meter, open-field test site. The EUT was placed on a nonconductive turntable 0.8 meters above the ground plane. The spectrum was examined from 9 kHz to the 10th harmonic of the highest fundamental transmitter frequency (24.8 GHz).

At each frequency, the EUT was rotated 360°, and the antenna was raised and lowered from 1 to 4 meters in order to determine the emission's maximum level. Measurements were taken using both horizontal and vertical antenna polarizations. For frequencies between 30 and 1000 MHz, the spectrum analyzer's 6 dB bandwidth was set to 120 kHz, and the analyzer was operated in the CISPR quasi-peak detection mode. For emissions above 1,000 MHz, emissions are measured using the average detector function with a minimum resolution bandwidth of 1 MHz. No video filter less than 10 times the resolution bandwidth was used. The highest emission amplitudes relative to the appropriate limit were measured and recorded in this report.

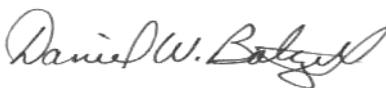

4.1 Band Edge Test Procedure

The transmitter output was connected to its appropriate antenna. Peak (1 MHz RBW/3 MHz VBW) and average (1 MHz RBW/10 Hz VBW) corrected radiated measurements were taken within the restricted band to show compliance.

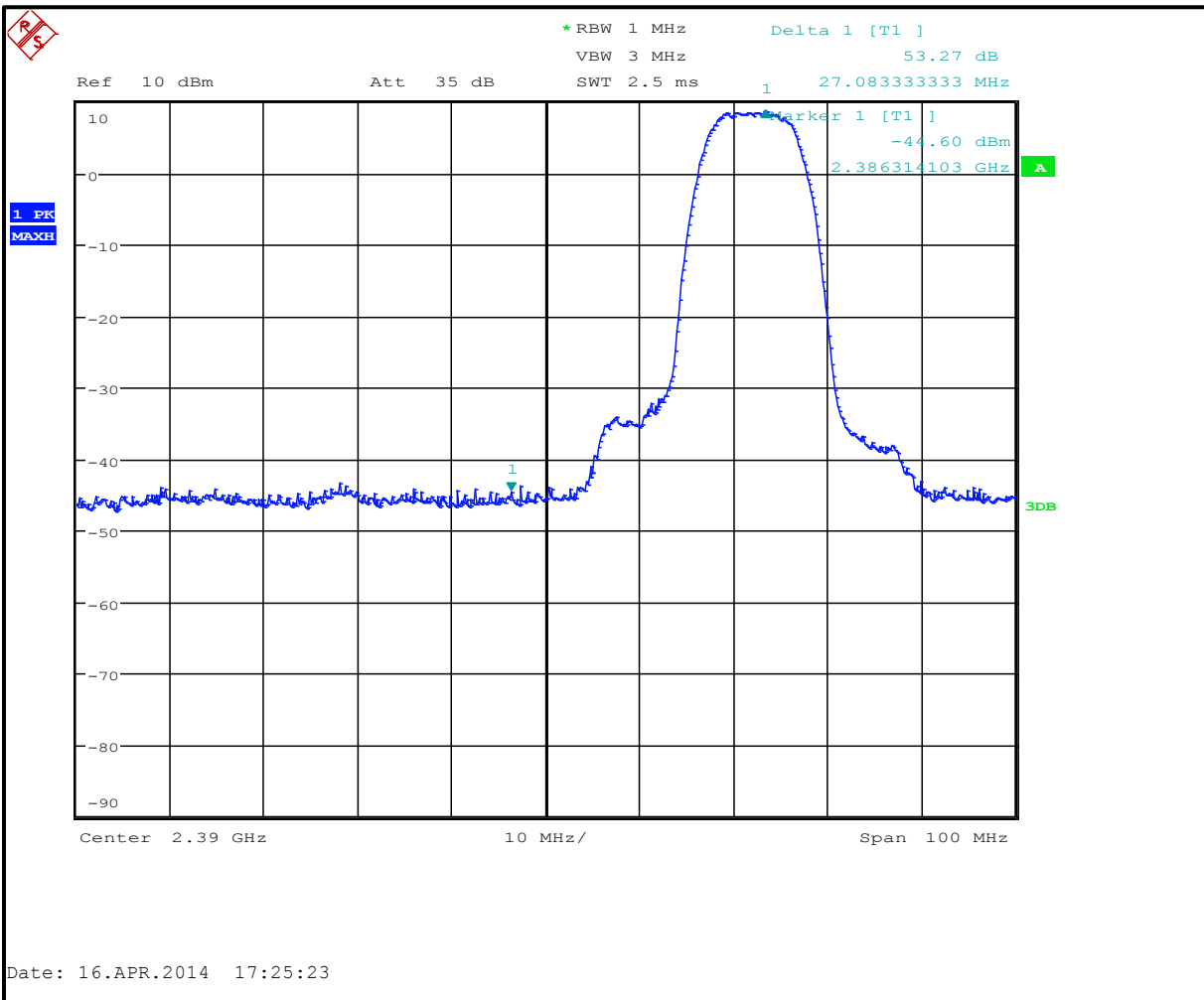
4.2.1 Lower Band Edge – 802.11b

95.9 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 53.3 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 42.6 dB. This level has a margin of 11.4 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $95.9 \text{ dBuV/m} - 53.3 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -11.4 \text{ dB}$

Plot 4-1: In Band Emissions - Channel 1 (2412 MHz); 802.11b (11 Mbps)



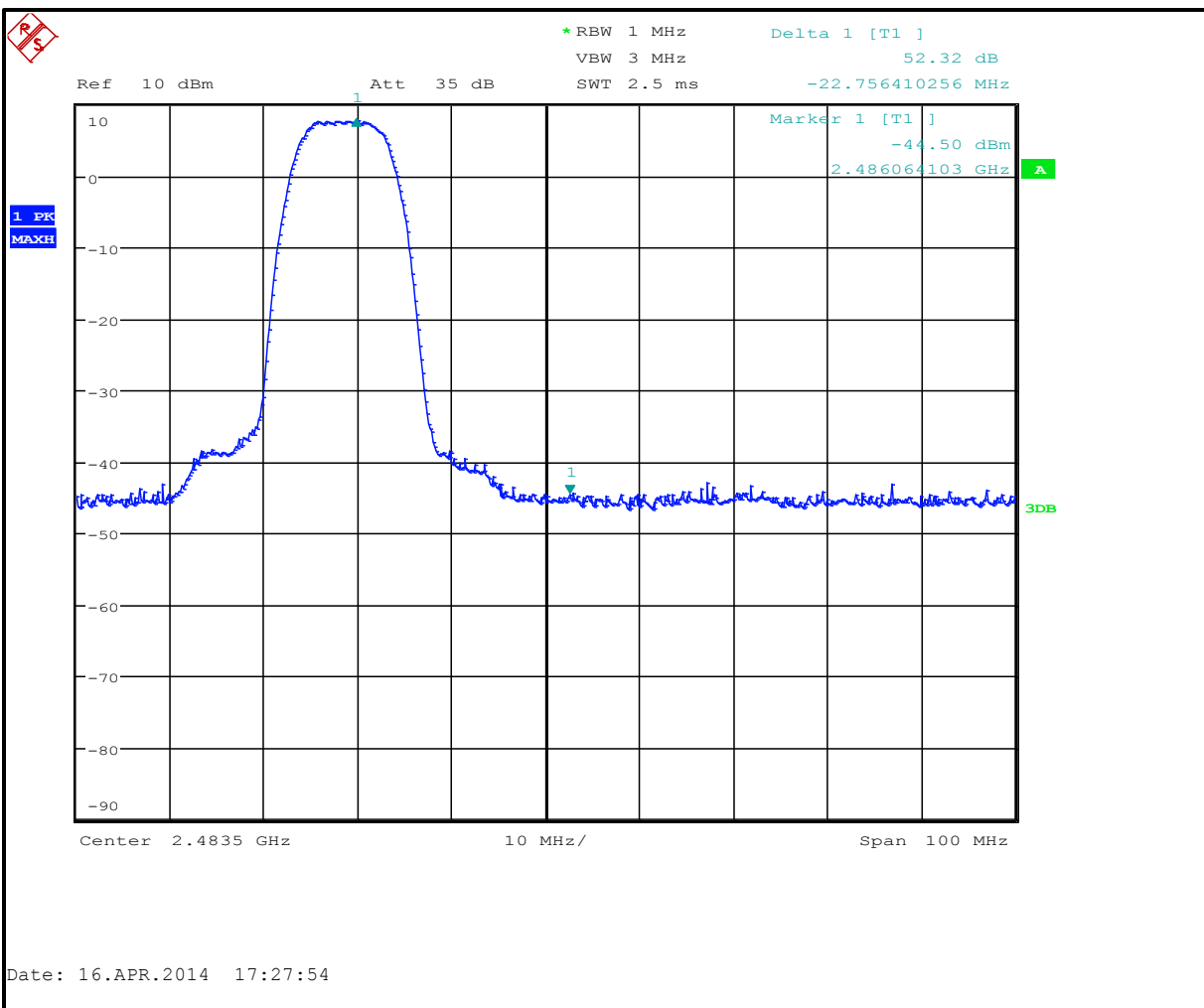
4.2.2 Upper Band Edge – 802.11b

93.6 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 52.3 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 41.3 dB. This level has a margin of 12.7 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $93.6 \text{ dBuV/m} - 52.3 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -12.7 \text{ dB}$

Peak Field Strength of Upper Band Edge (1 MHz RBW/1 MHz VBW) = 102.2 dBuV/m

Plot 4-2: In Band Emissions - Channel 13 (2462 MHz); 802.11b (11 Mbps)



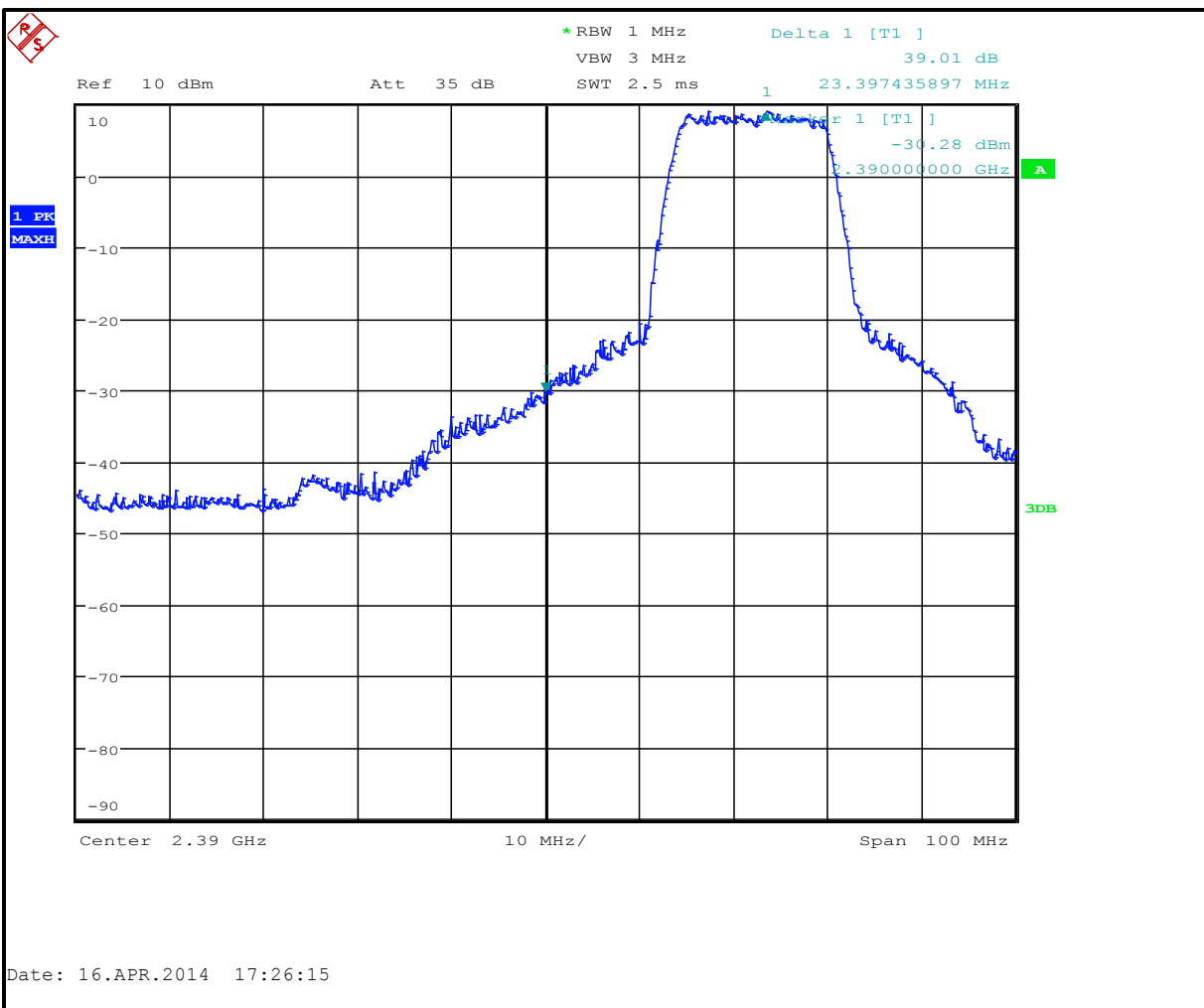
4.2.3 Lower Band Edge – 802.11g

90.7 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 39.0 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 51.7 dB. This level has a margin of 2.3 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $90.7 \text{ dBuV/m} - 39.0 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -2.3 \text{ dB}$

Plot 4-3: In Band Emissions - Channel 1 (2412 MHz); 802.11g (54 Mbps)



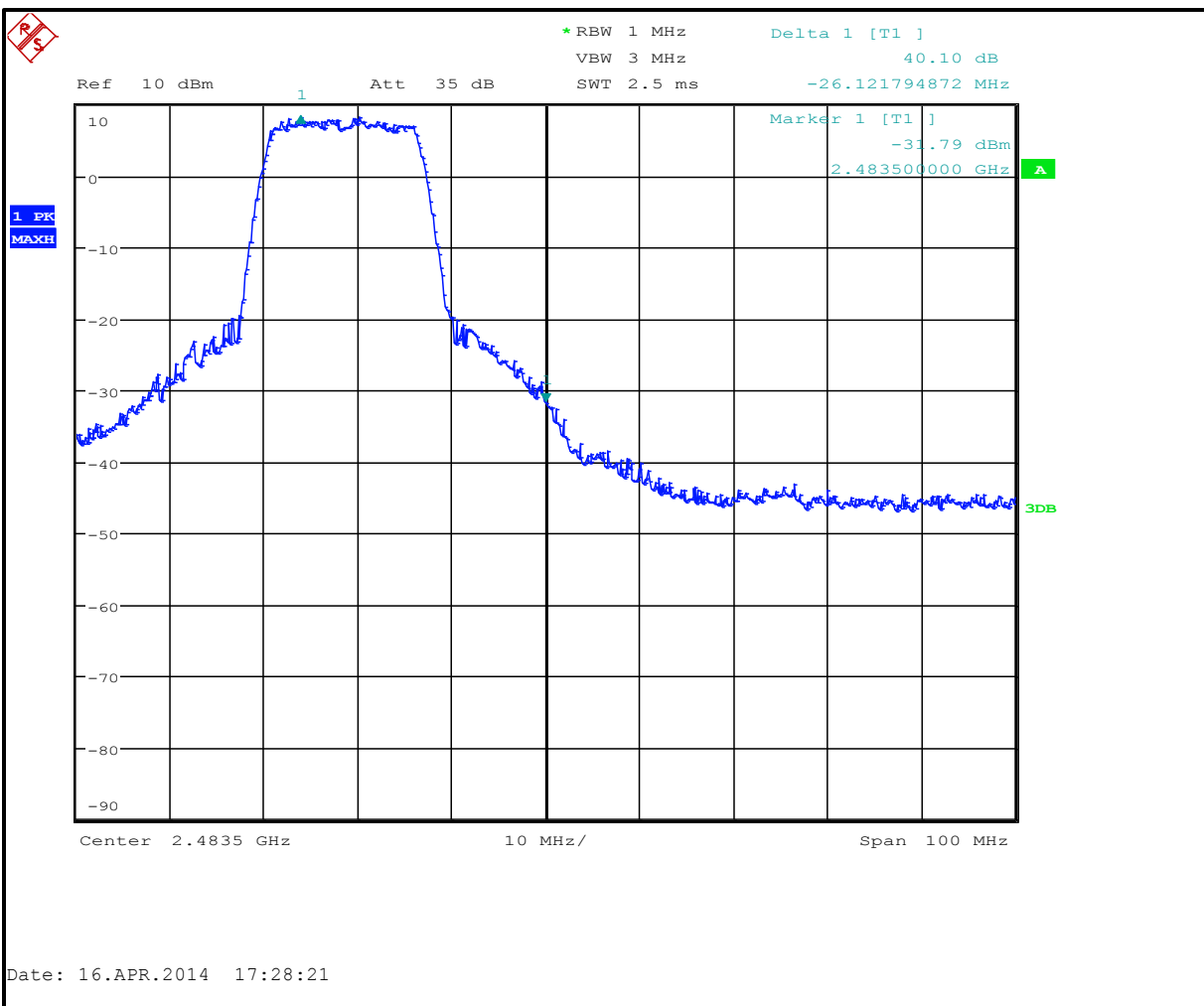
4.2.4 Upper Band Edge – 802.11g

88.8 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 40.1 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 48.7 dB. This level has a margin of 5.3 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $88.8 \text{ dBuV/m} - 40.1 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -5.3 \text{ dB}$

Plot 4-4: In Band Emissions - Channel 13 (2462 MHz); 802.11g (54 Mbps)



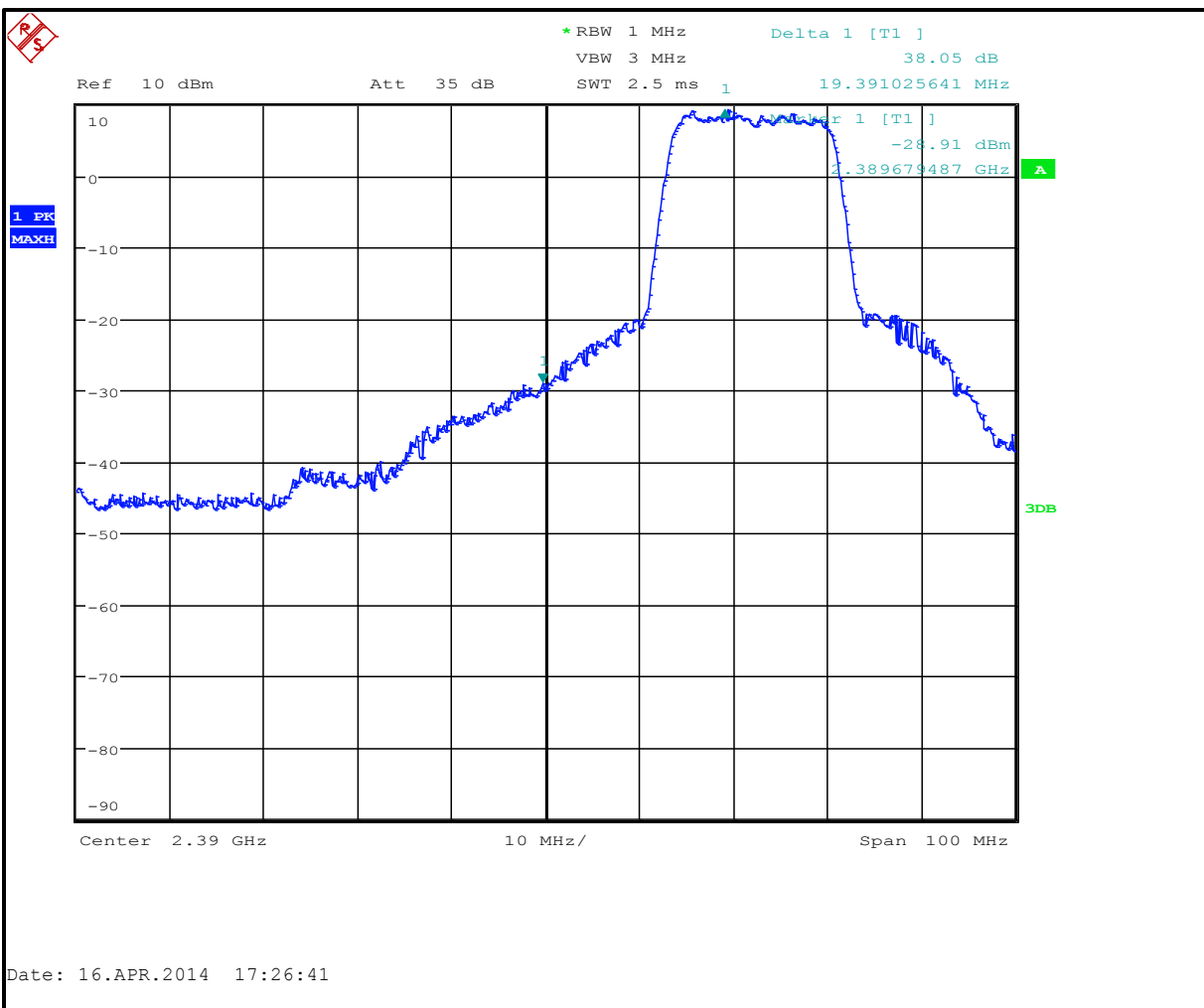
4.2.5 Lower Band Edge – 802.11n

90.7 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 38.1 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 52.6 dB. This level has a margin of 1.4 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $90.7 \text{ dBuV/m} - 38.1 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -1.4 \text{ dB}$

Peak Field Strength of Lower Band Edge (1 MHz RBW/3 MHz VBW) = 102.9 dBuV/m
 Average Field Strength of Lower Band Edge (1 MHz RBW/10 Hz VBW) = 90.7 dBuV/m

Plot 4-5: In Band Emissions - Channel 1 (2412 MHz); 802.11n (65 Mbps)



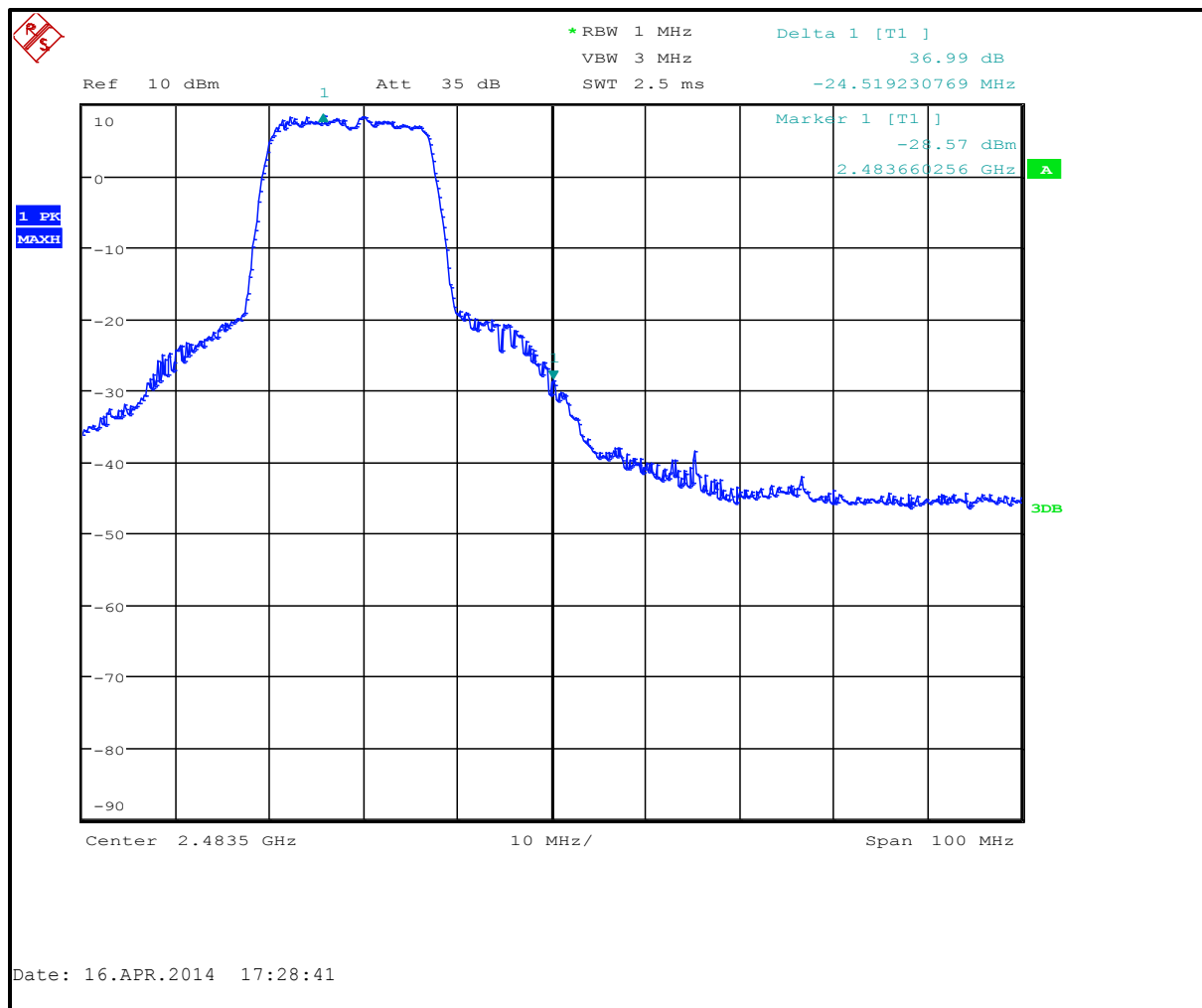
4.2.6 Upper Band Edge – 802.11n

88.9 dBuV/m is the average field strength measurement, from which the delta measurement of 37.0 dB is subtracted (reference plots), resulting in a level 51.9 dB. This level has a margin of 2.1 dB below the limit of 54 dBuV/m.

Calculation: $88.9 \text{ dBuV/m} - 37.0 \text{ dB} - 54 \text{ dBuV/m} = -2.1 \text{ dB}$

Peak Field Strength of Upper Band Edge (1 MHz RBW/1 MHz VBW) = 101.4 dBuV/m
Average Field Strength of Upper Band Edge (1 MHz RBW/10 Hz VBW) = 88.9 dBuV/m
Delta measurement = 37.0 dB
