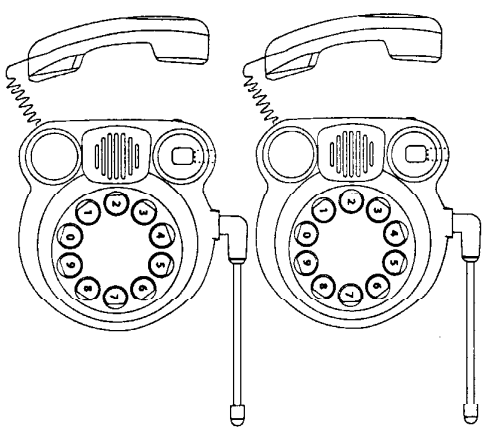

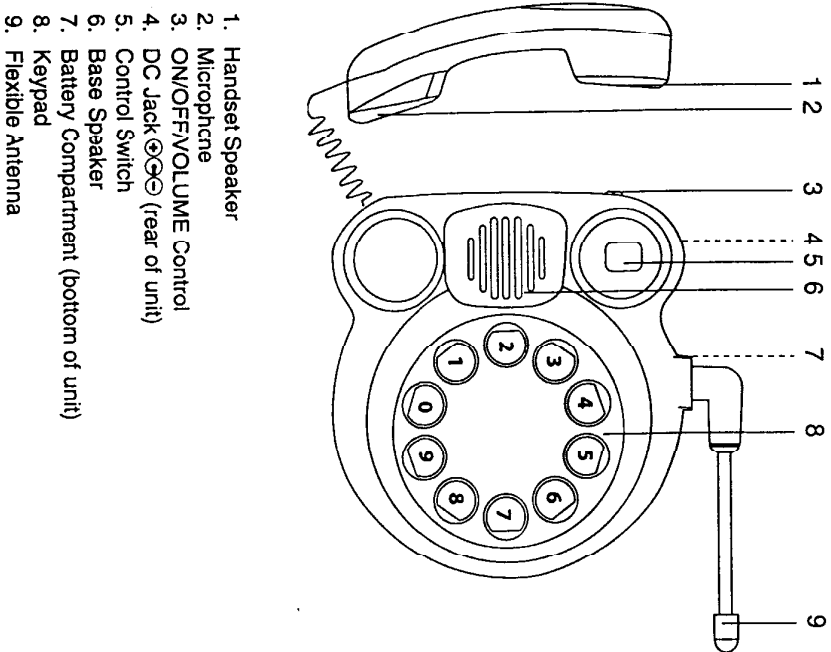

INFORMATION:

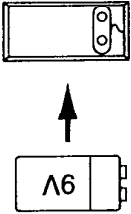
LOCATION OF CONTROLS

BATTERY OPERATION

1. Remove the Battery Compartment cover on the bottom of the unit by removing the screw and then lifting it out.
2. Insert a 9V battery into the compartment following the diagram shown.
3. Replace the Battery Compartment cover and screw.



BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

- Follow these precautions when using a battery in this device:
1. Use only the size and type of battery specified.
 2. Be sure to follow the correct polarity when installing the battery as indicated in the battery compartment. A reversed battery may cause damage to the device.
 3. If the device is not to be used for a long period of time, remove the battery to prevent damage or injury from possible battery leakage.
 4. Do not try to recharge a battery not intended to be recharged; it can overheat and rupture. (Follow battery manufacturer's directions.)

AC OPERATION

To operate the unit using AC power, connect a UL approved AC adapter (not included) having a 9V negative center (⊖) to the DC jack on the rear of the unit and to a wall outlet having 120V, 60Hz AC only. The battery is automatically disconnected when an AC adapter is used.

OPERATION

1. Rotate both ON/OFF/VOLUME controls clockwise until a click is heard to turn the units on. Continue to rotate to adjust the volume.
2. Lift Handset (which will release the Control switch) and press the "7", "8", "9" or "0" keys on the keypad to ring the other unit.
3. Lift the second Handset to answer.
4. These units are designed so both parties can talk at the same time. When transmitting, speak in a normal tone.
5. After use, rotate both ON/OFF/VOLUME controls counter-clockwise until a click is heard to turn the units off.

NOTE: When the sound becomes weak, replace the battery.
