Gentlemen:

The attached documentation is provided in support of a formal submission to your organization for FCC certification of an intentional unlicensed transmitter. On behalf of our client, Compatible Electronics, Inc. has included an application for a Grant of Equipment Authorization pursuant to Subpart C of part 15 of FCC Rules (47 CFR) regarding intentional radiators. The data within the test report demonstrates the equipment was tested in a manner described under Part 2 and 15 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

The submittal is for approval of the 802.11b MiniPCI Type IIIB Wireless Module (Model: WM3B2100, FCC ID: CNTHSTNN-I01C) installed in a Hewlett Packard Notebook Computer (Series HSTNN-I01C with a set of Wistron NeWeb Corporation triple band antennas.)

For this submittal the 802.11b MiniPCI Type IIIB Wireless Module (Model: WM3B2100, FCC-ID: CNTHSTNN-I01C) is not considered the EUT (Equipment Under Test). The EUT is the Hewlett Packard Notebook Computer Series HSTN-I01C.

Please note that the MiniPCI Type IIIB Wireless Module is the exact same module tested under the FCC-ID: CNTPP2090. The difference is instead of the MiniPCI Type IIIB Wireless Module being tested in the Hewlett Packard Notebook Computer Series PP 2090, the MiniPCI Type IIIB Wireless Module is being tested in the Hewlett Packard Notebook Computer Series HSTNN-I01C.
