The module must comply with all specific rules applicable to the transmitter, including all the conditions provided in the integration instructions by the grantee	Yes	The module approved transmitter complies with all applicable rules and the integration manual contains any specific requirements addressed to the integrator and/or to the end-user of the final end-product.
