Mr. Rogers:

Regarding the FCC ID label location in the application for FCC ID: IPH-01853, Garmin International wishes to place the label on the inside surface of the battery compartment. The battery compartment is an area requiring repeated user attention as operation of the unit requires user replacement of the battery periodically. Since the unit will not ship with the battery installed, the user will be required to look at the FCC ID label prior to the initial use of the product. Furthermore, the label will be seen each time the battery is replaced.

The battery compartment is easily accessible and the battery is removable by the user without the use of any special tools. The identifier is visible on the interior surface of the battery compartment as soon as the battery door is removed in order to replace the battery. The identifier is placed in such a location that it will be visible to the user each time the battery is replaced. The unit will be initially provided with no batteries installed, so the user will be forced to look at the ID prior to operating the unit.
